Questions and Answers:

- Q1. Note 2 on drawing B-57 states that the contractor shall obtain all permits. Is a building permit required for the new control building?
- A1. A building permit is not required for the construction of the new control building.
- Q2. Questions regarding the Prefabricated Control Building:
- a) Please provide the Interior wall height dimension (floor to ceiling).
- A2. a) Many electrical cabinets are 8 feet tall, so 10 feet (3.0 m) floor to ceiling height would be required. As specified on the structural drawing (S-57) "Prefabricated or cast-in-place building to be designed by the Contractor".
- Q2. b) Regarding the exterior finish of walls. We can pre-fabricate the walls with plain, grey concrete and a sandblast finish but if the client is looking for something more aesthetically pleasing then we can pre-fabricate the walls with a simulated block and/or brick pattern with stain to provide a more realistic appearance. Please advise if there any specific requirements?
- A2. b) Provide pre-fabricated exterior walls finished as per Section 13 34 23 Part 2. Use cedar shingles.
- Q3. Could you please confirm that all galvanized structural steel below deck level (such as floor beams, stringers and bottom braces) should also be painted?
- A3. Only the truss structural steel above deck level including the bottom chords excluding the contact surfaces of bolted joints are to be coated. Please refer to Note #8 on Drawing B-24.
- Q4. Could you also confirm that the metalized pivot girder and the metalized pivot diaphragm must also be painted?
- A4. Only the truss structural steel above deck level including the bottom chords excluding the contact surfaces of bolted joints are to be coated. Please refer to Note #8 on Drawing B-24.
- Q6. Could you please confirm that the galvanized railings and the galvanized railing post that shown on the swing bridge and on the fixed bridge should also be painted.
- A6. The galvanized railings and galvanized railing posts are also to be coated.
