#### Part 1. Interpretation

- 1.1 Elections Canada hereby amends in accordance with this amendment the Request for Proposal for Voter Information Campaign for the 43rd General Election Various Promotional Items bearing number ECAT-RFP-18-0234 and dated August 2, 2018 (the "RFP"). This amendment hereby forms part of the RFP.
- 1.2 Unless defined herein or unless the context otherwise requires, all of the words and phrases defined in the RFP and used in this amendment shall have the same meanings assigned to them in the RFP.

#### Part 2. Questions and Answers

The following questions have been asked in response to the Request for Proposal and Elections Canada hereby answers as follows:

#### 2.1 Question No. 3

#### Question:

Is it possible to send us the SKU of Backpack you are requesting?

If you can't send the SKU would it be possible to borrow the bag for a few hours, so we can source the item?

#### Answer:

A sample of EC 99023 from the last general election is available and will be provided upon request.

#### 2.2 Question No. 4

#### Question:

The RFP in Part 1, 3.2.2 you state the following

The technical proposal should address clearly and in sufficient depth the points that are subject to the evaluation criteria against which the proposal will be evaluated which are set out in Part 7 — Technical Evaluation Criteria. Simply repeating the statement contained in the RFP is not sufficient. In order to facilitate the evaluation of the proposal, Elections Canada requests that bidders address and present topics in the order of the evaluation criteria under the same headings. To avoid duplication, bidders may refer to different sections of their proposal by identifying the specific paragraph and page number where the subject topic has already been addressed.

However, Part 7- Technical Evaluation Criteria has M1 as clearly marked that all we should do is either mark Yes or No. I don't believe you expect anything else from us for M1, is that correct? If you are expecting more please provide the topics you expect us to address.

#### Answer:

That is correct – Elections Canada does not expect anything else from what is requested in M1. As such, the Request for Proposal is amended in accordance with Section 3.2 of this amendment.

#### 2.3 Question No. 5

#### Question:

The RFP in Part 1, 3.2.3 you state the following

The details of any client references requested under Part 7 – Technical Evaluation Criteria should be submitted with the proposal. If any of the required information is not submitted as requested, in the event that Elections Canada decides to contact client references, the Contracting Authority will so inform the bidder and provide the bidder with a time frame within which to meet the requirement. If the bidder fails to comply with the request of the Contracting Authority and meet the requirement within that time period, the proposal will be deemed non-responsive.

However, Part 7- Technical Evaluation Criteria has M1 has not mention or direction regarding client references. I don't believe you expect any references, is that correct? If you are expecting references, please provide the details of what you expect.

#### Answer:

That is correct – at this time, Elections Canada is not requesting any client references in Part 7 – Technical Evaluation Criteria.

#### 2.4 Question No. 6

#### Question:

The RFP in Part 7, M2 you state the following

Bidder must provide an acceptable sample that complies with all requirements described in Annex A – Specifications for the item(s) for which they are submitting a proposal. Elections Canada will evaluate the sample provided by the Bidder. Failure to comply with this requirement will deem your proposal non-responsive.

When you mention "sample" are you referring to images or do you think they mean a "physical sample"?

We would put standard images within our proposal. Our standard images within our proposals similar to the RFP would look like the following



#### Answer:

Yes, for the purpose of the technical evaluation, Bidders must provide a physical sample. As such, the Request for Proposal is amended in accordance with Section 3.3 of this amendment.
