**AMENDMENT # 3**

Further to the original Request for Proposal (RFP) document published on July 19, 2018, which was amended on August 22, 2018 and August 30, 2018.

This amendment is to address the Bidder Questions on the insurance requirements of the RFP as follows:

	<b>Bidder Questions</b>	<b>ECCC Responses</b>
1	Item O – Limited Pollution coverage is 72 hours vs. requested 120 hour coverage. What is the intent / applicability of the 120 hour provision for a laboratory? Is 72 hours acceptable for the nature of this work?	Item “o” - Accidental pollution is not likely to happen with the nature of the work to be performed under this file (analysis of frozen fish samples supplied by ECCC). It has been assessed that the risk is minimal. The recommended no. of hours is reduced to a range of 60-80 hrs.
2	Item P - What is the intent or applicability of this item to the work described? ECCC is the owner and interpreter of the resultant data. The Supplier is not expected to provide interpretation of the significance or implication of the results to the environment or property.	Item “p” on Litigation Rights is hereby deleted.
3	The RFP requests a letter (part 6, item 2) to indicate insurance company’s acceptance to provide insurance. Is provision of an existing insurance certificate a suitable substitute for this requirement?	As long as the existing insurance certificate meets the requirements in Annex D “Insurance Requirements” (with noted changes above), then yes, pre-existing insurance coverage would be acceptable.
