1. INQUIRIES DURING THE SOLICITATION PERIOD

ITEM #	QUESTION	ANSWER
1	The posting gives no details of the cell bed. We manufacture platform beds with optional tie-downs and a rotationally molded bed both of which we market to psychiatric hospitals and detention centers.	Refer to specificatuion Section 12 55 00 Institutional Free Standing Bunks, to see if your molded bed meets the requirements for this project.
2	We have reviewed the literature from our washroom accessory suppliers and the internet for these two items and we cannot locate items that exactly meet the specifications. Models of paper towel dispenser that dispense rolls that are surface mounted that we can locate are Frost Model 102, Frost Model 109-60S and Frost 109 50S Can you advise if any of these would be acceptable. We do not believe that any of them have the galvanized interior as described in the addendum.	Roll Paper Towel dispenser: The institution currently uses Cascade Pro DH05 A1 which would be an acceptable alternate. Frost Model 109-60S is an acceptable alternate.
3	We cannot locate any wall mounted plastic garbage bin with a self closing lid with that capacity or dimensions. Can you advise the manufacturer and model number for this please. The closest unit that we can find that matches the view on the revised plan sheet below is the Frost model 303 that we have attached and this comes is either white enamel or stainless steel with a different size and capacity that the specified plastic garbage bin.	The Frost model 303 is an acceptable alternate. The specification was based on a Rubbermaid Wall Mounted Waste receptacle.
.4	What is the material being used for the cabinetry? The section of storage shelving shows plastic laminate for all exposed surfaces but nothing for cabinetry behind doors.	The intent of the spec. section is to meet AWMAC Custom Grade requirements. We specified both plastic laminate and wood casework. The drawings indicate the different types. The AWMAC manual has most of the

	General practice would be melamine behind doors & plastic laminate to all exposed. Plastic laminate throughout would be very costly	necessary details. While it does not specifically indicate it in the section, melamine interiors would be acceptable.
.5	Also, do you require standards & clips for adj shelves as per drawings or pins in 32mm holes as per spec? Do you have any more info regarding cabinet hardware for actual model numbers?	Ajustable shelves hardware to be as per the specifications. Cabinet hardware is specified under Article 2.08.
