Question 1	After reading the Ineligibility and Suspension Policy, it is my understanding we do not have any Certifications to file... (The certifications are unable to be completed by U.S. entities anyways). Can you confirm?
Answer 1	<p>All certifications in the RFP are required for all Bidders including US Bidders. Please refer to Section 5.1.1 of the RFP and SACC 2003 Standard Instructions – Section 01 Integrity Provisions – bid.</p> <p>For added clarity, the Integrity Declaration Form is only required if the Bidder is unable to provide any of the certifications required by Subsection 4 of Section 01 of SACC 2003. Bidders must also provide the information (List of Names) required by the Ineligibility and Suspension Policy described under the heading "Information to be Provided when Bidding, Contracting or Entering into a Real Property Agreement." Amendment #1	<p>DELETE "Section 5.1. – Certification Required" in its entirety and INSERT the following:</p> <p>5.1 Certifications Required</p> <p>Bidders must submit the following duly completed certifications.</p> <p>5.1.1 Integrity Provisions - Declaration of Convicted Offences</p> <p>In accordance with the Integrity Provisions of the Standard Instructions, all bidders must provide with their bid, if applicable, the Integrity declaration form available on the <u>Forms for the Integrity Regime</u> website (http://www.tpsgc-pwgsc.gc.ca/ci-if/declaration-eng.html), to be given further consideration in the procurement process, but should mail it directly to the address specified on the form and should not include it with their bid submission by e-mail.</p>
