SOLICITATION AMENDMENT # 004

This solicitation amendment is raised to:

1. Address the following questions submitted during the solicitation period as per RFP; and
2. Amend the RFP.

1. QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

Q 33. Will a zone list be made available? We will need to ensure the 4020-replacement panels will accommodate the existing zone counts for the PC5010 and Focus 128.

A33. The zones will not be made available. Upon contract award, a site visit will be required.

Q34. Which locations have maxed out on keypads? Have these counts been included in the amended financial proposal section?

A34. CRA is not aware of any sites being maxed out on keypads so there are no amendments to the financial proposal section.

Q35. Regarding Q11 and A11: If the panels are locked out we will not be able to program them after a reset. Will CRA assume the cost of replacing the panel(s) and providing a zone list to reprogram?

A35. The cost will be covered for the panels but as previously stated, we will not be able to provide a zone list. The service provider will have to work with local security to establish the zone list.

Q36. Another follow up, Q25-A25 - We will require the quantity of zones and keypads for updating the panel to DSC 4020 in Moncton in order to provide the appropriate quantities of expanders if required.

A36. The quantity of zones and keypads will be determined at a site visit upon contract award. Zone expander costs are part of the panel costs as per the financial proposal.

Q37. Regarding Q26 and A26 which requires further clarification.

A37. No list will be provided. The cost is not dependant on system size. A site visit will be required and each site will have a different requirement. The financial proposal includes a section for the bidder to indicate the hourly rate to be charged to CRA to reprogram the intrusion alarm system.

Q38. Regarding Q19 and A19: Is part of the scope to have each new and existing 4020 programmed to the existing monitoring station? Alarms will generate on the Kantech systems graphics, as well as the monitoring station?

A38. Yes, that is the final outcome that is required from this RFP.

Q39. Based on the sites description tables on Appendix A of the RFP, the panels count does not match with the quantity of KT4401 interfaces requested on the amendment #2 pricing template.

- Ontario = 30 alarm panels --> amendment2 = 10 KT4401
- Prairies = 12 alarm panels --> amendment2 = 6 KT4401
- HQ = 119 alarm panels --> amendment2 = 42 KT4401

The Questions is should we quote based on the description tables on Appendix A of the RFP or the amendment #2 pricing template quantities?

A39. Quotes should be as per the pricing template in Amendment #002.



Q40. The provided answer to question 10, A10; says "Zones will be determined with direction from local security once the contract is awarded". This task will require a walk thru and testing point by point every zone and devices. This may take 1 hour or multiple days depending on the number of zones per panel and amount of devices. How do you want us to price this service?

A40. This hourly rate in the financial proposal is meant to cover the price of this service.

Q41. Would CRA consider a two week extension in support of our bid preparation / submission?

A41. Cra will provide a one week extension to the RFP. Please refer to RFP Amendment #004 for the new closing date.

Q42. Can the bidder make the assumption for this tender that the DSC Panels that require an interface to the Kantech controller boards are within the same location? If the RS232 communication cable required between the two devices is over the maximum distance of 50ft, then extra hardware and cabling may be required.

A42. Yes they are in the same space.

Q43. Replacing and pricing the PC4020, are we to include power supply, battery, keypad and transformer?

A43. Yes

Q44. Table B7, do you want All inclusive labor rate for each item in A7 or a total as there is only one line item? Are all sites on the National Network?

A44. Yes, we require an all-inclusive labour rate. All sites are on the National Network.

Q45. Regarding Q25-A25 - We will require the quantity of zones and keypads for updating the panel to DSC 4020 in Moncton in order to provide the appropriate quantities of expanders if required.

A45. All items are to be priced for as per the pricing table and upon contract award a walkthrough will be done to determine the required amount.

Please note: The number of zones and contact points per site may be available at a later date but for the purpose of this RFP, the bidder must assume that this information will not be provided. Please review the questions and answer already provided.
