Question 1. Do Bidders have to be registered in the Controlled Goods Program in order to participate in the Contract bid process?

Answer 1: Yes, Bidders must be registered in the Controlled Goods Program to Bid on the Requirement, The contract will include provisions regarding the Controlled Goods Program (CGP) and will include information about controlled goods that are subject to the Defence Production Act, R.S. 1985, c. D-1.

Question 2: What kind of Controlled Goods will be part of the Contract?

Answer 2: The Controlled Goods contained in the Contract include:

Export Control List

Group 1 Dual –Use List, all categories

Group 2 Munitions List, may contain all items

Group 5 Miscellaneous Goods and Technology. Items 5400 and 5505
