ANNEX A REQUIREMENT and BASIS OF PAYMENT

1. Category Selection

Combined Categories Rule: For reasons of compatibility, the following categories will be combined for evaluation and contract award purposes: The rule only applies to the categories below that are checked. The unchecked categories will be evaluated separately and may be awarded to multiple suppliers; Category 1 Category 2 **Design Upgrade Rule:** The IU may exercise an option to upgrade products up to 20% of each Category product total before Applicable Taxes after contract award. The Design Upgrade amount is used at the discretion of the Project Authority (PA). Within ten business days of the contract award, the PA will provide the Contractor with a written notice of Canada's Design Upgrade choices for each of the product(s) to be upgraded. The Contractor will provide the pricing of the upgraded product(s) to a maximum of 20% of each Category Contract Price of Table 8. The Contracting Authority will issue an amendment to the contract with the Design Upgrades and pricing. The Supplier certifies that all the Design Upgraded products offered will conform to all specifications and meet the testing requirements detailed in the Specifications of the Supply Arrangement.

Design Upgrade: is the process of replacing a product with a more innovative or enhanced version of the same product.
