SPECIFICATION Epaulettes, Rank, Woven

1. **Definition**

- 1.1 This specification must govern the manufacture and inspection of Epaulettes, Rank, Woven. The specific items covered under this specification with stock numbers are as follows:

3. General Requirements

- 3.1 The article or material covered by this specification must be free from material and manufacturing defects that may affect its appearance or serviceability. In all particulars not covered by this specification or contract documents, production must be equivalent in all respects to the viewing sample.
- 3.2 <u>**Design**</u> The epaulettes must be designed in accordance with the drawings attached and forming part of this specification; and the viewing sample.

4. **Detail Requirements**

4.1 **Components**

4.1.1 <u>Yarn</u> – All yarns, when woven, must meet the requirements outlined in Table I.

- 4.1.1.1 <u>Warp Yarn</u> The warp yarn must be 100% polyester, between 90 to 150 denier, black in colour.
- 4.1.1.2 <u>Ground Yarns</u> The ground yarns must be 100% polyester, between 90 to 150 denier, navy blue or royal blue in colour as applicable.
- 4.1.1.3 <u>Design Yarns</u> The design yarns must be 100% polyester, between 50 to 100 denier, in a combination or gold, royal blue, red, white, green, purple, gray, and black colours as applicable. The colour reference must be as indicated in Table I.
- 4.1.2 <u>Thread, Stitching</u> The thread must be polyester wrap, polyester core, Tex 40, Type II of matching colour to the shell material, meeting U.S. government standard A-A-50199A.
- 4.2 <u>Size and Dimensions</u> The Epaulettes, Woven must be sized and dimensioned as per the drawings.

4.3 **Construction**

- 4.3.1 <u>Weaving</u> The weaving must be 1 x 3 right hand twill. All design yarns must be bound down. The design yarns must not show through the ground yarns except as part of the design itself. The epaulettes must be similar, respective to their design and size.
- 4.3.2 <u>Finish</u> All epaulettes must have a resin hand building finish. The epaulettes must be interlined, the edges serged or sealed, then sewn and pressed forming a sleeve with the insignia properly centered as per viewing sample.

5. Quality Assurance Provisions

- 5.1 <u>Responsibility for Inspection</u> Unless otherwise stipulated in the contract, it is the prime contractor's responsibility to satisfy the RCMP, Uniform and Equipment Program that the material and services being supplied conform to this tender, contract and specification. This must be accomplished by performing the tests specified in this specification. The contractor must use a commercial testing establishment acceptable to the RCMP, Uniform and Equipment Program.
- 5.2 The RCMP, Uniform and Equipment Program reserves the right to perform any inspection considered necessary to ensure the material and services conform to the


specified requirements. Inspection may be done during manufacture and is subject to testing and approval by the RCMP Uniform and Equipment Program. Imperfections must be assessed in accordance with current RCMP practice. If the cloth is found to be inferior to the viewing sample or not in accordance with this specification, the entire delivery may be rejected. The entire delivery may also be rejected if it is found that materials previously rejected due to non-repairable defects are redelivered for inspection.

5.3 The contractor will be promptly notified when any articles are not accepted and such articles will be returned at the contractor's risk and expense.






Epaulette, Rank, Woven #3360-407 Epaulette, Rank, Sergeant





Epaulette, Rank, Woven #3360-504 Epaulette, Rank, Staff Sergeant









Epaulette, Rank, Woven #3370-100 Epaulette, Rank, Staff Sergeant Major








Epaulette, Rank, Woven #3370-305 Epaulette, Rank, Corps Sergeant Major











Epaulette, Rank, Woven #3362-412 Epaulette, Rank, Sergeant, Subdued









Epaulette, Rank, Woven #3362-508 Epaulette, Rank, Staff Sergeant, Subdued








Epaulette, Rank, Woven #3372-209 Epaulette, Rank, Staff Sergeant Major, Subdued
















Epaulette, Rank, Woven #4662-048 Epaulette, Rank, Superintendent, Subdued












Epaulette, Rank, Woven Epaulette Details

Single Chevrons




Multiple Chevrons


Epaulette, Rank, Woven Epaulette Details




Small Crown Detail





Large Crown Detail




Leaves for Staff Sergeant Major
