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## **Request for Proposal (RFP): W8472-195743/A SMART Antenna, ANTI-JAM PROTECTION**

**This Amendment is raised to extend to extend the solicitation closing date and to answer Bidder Questions.**

**Question 1.** Will Canada specify the required Anti-Jam J/S performance specification (measured in dB)?

**Answer 1:** No

**Question 2.** In the interest of increasing Anti-Jam resistance from multiple adversary jammers and other sources of shipboard interference, will you increase the minimum number of antenna elements by mandating that up to 6 jamming sources must be handled by the AJ solution concurrently?

**Answer 2.** No. As stated in the TSOR, the requirement is for the protection against a minimum of three (3) jamming sources.

**Question 3.** Will Canada accept a full-featured solution that includes the CRPA physical antenna, the AJ antenna and other electronics to provide PNT directly to the NavDDS, bypassing any compatibility issues with the installed GPS cards?

**Answer 3.** As stated in the TSOR, any proposed Anti-Jamming solution must interface with the current fitted GPS receiver.

**Question 4.** Please confirm that proposals must include both the physical CRPA antenna and the antenna electronics package that performs the AJ function (whether integrated together into one unit or not?).

**Answer 4.** Correct. Proposals must include both the physical CRPA antenna and the antenna electronics package which performs the anti-jam function. Proposed solutions may be integrated together into one unit or may consist of multiple units.

**Question 5.** The real AJ performance happens in the antenna electronics. Will Canada specify a specific physical CRPA antenna to provide a common basis of assessment for all proposed antenna electronics AJ systems?

**Answer 5.** No, Canada will not specify a specific physical CRPA antenna.

**Question 6.** System AJ performance is best when simultaneous L1/L2 protection is provided by a true 2- channel architecture and not a time multiplexed single channel. Is this the intent in this RFP?

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**Answer 6.** As stated in the TSOR, Canada requires that the proposed solution provide simultaneous L1/L2 protection. The method to obtain simultaneous L1/L2 protection is not specified.

**Question 7.** An RFP seeking a lowest-cost solution is likely to procure a less capable AJ solution for the RCN to test, compared to a ‘best value’ evaluation. Can the evaluation be changed to award rated points to valuable capabilities such as:

- An AJ system with more antenna elements/channels, providing protection from more jamming sources
- Increased J/S performance
- M-Code compatibility
- Direction finding capability
- Simultaneous 2-channel L1/L2 protection

**Answer 7.** No, Canada will not change the evaluation to a ‘best value’. The evaluation will remain ‘lowest cost compliant’.

**Question 8.** In anticipation of Canada’s response to various questions, and to provide enough time to address Canada’s requirements, will Canada extend the solicitation closing date by an additional two weeks?
