1. Is there any pit plans available for layout of plant and stockpile areas?
2. Are there any test pit logs on any of the pits to be used for the tender?
3. What are the liquidated damages for not completing project for Jan 25, 2019?
4. Have these products been produced out of these pits in the past without washing requirements?
5. Is there specific quantities that are required at each pit location? Can all materials be produced in one pit?
6. Is contractor responsible for hauling materials produced materials from one pit to another?
7. Can a radial stacker be utilized for stockpiling materials?
8. Is there any additional compensation for Drilling and Blasting of frozen infeed material if required?

Answers

1. No pit plans are available. The bidders are to note that a truck will need to be used at Stringer Pit to move material down to lower level and stockpile. The cost of the truck and operator shall be incidental to the work.
2. No current logs are available.
3. The new project completion date is: March 11, 2019. (see below changes to specifications and please note that the Bid and Acceptance Form (BA) Revision 1 is required for submission)
