QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

Question 1: Is the "Reliability" level security clearance through PWGSC (form – TBS/SCT 330-23E(Rev.2006/02)) acceptable?

Answer 1: No, the RCMP security clearance process is separate from the PWGSC clearances.

Question 2: If the "Reliability" level security clearance through PWGSC is not acceptable, is there an expectation that this level of clearance is held at the time of proposal submission or can it be secured post contract award?

Answer 2: The RCMP security clearance process will be initiated after the tender closes and a bid is under consideration for contract award. Security clearance will need to be in place before the contract is awarded.

Question 3: Will individuals with engineering degrees and master's degrees in fire protection be considered equivalent to a Safety Codes Officer certification with the discipline of Fire Group B2 (inspector)?

Answer 3: Fire protection engineers with experience (years) similar to those of fire inspectors can be accepted as equivalent. For example, a fire protection engineer with 5 years' experience in the application of the NBC and NFC can be considered equal to or more qualified than a fire inspector with 5 years' experience in the application of the NFC.

All other terms and conditions remain the same.
