

## Advance Contract Award Notice (18-22096)

### Development of Training Products for the National Energy Code of Canada for Buildings 2015 (NECB)

#### 1. An explanation of what an ACAN is.

An ACAN is a public notice indicating to the supplier community that a department or agency intends to award a contract for goods, services or construction to a pre-identified supplier, thereby allowing other suppliers to signal their interest in bidding, by submitting a statement of capabilities. If no supplier submits a statement of capabilities that meets the requirements set out in the ACAN, on or before the closing date stated in the ACAN, the contracting officer may then proceed with the award to the pre-identified supplier.

#### 2. Definition of the requirement:

The provider, CSA, will develop training material for practitioners in regards to utilizing and adhering to the National Energy Code of Canada for Buildings (2015). The project requires material for a 4-hour online course and a one-day instructor led course and pathway for certification of successful individuals that demonstrate completion of the course

#### 3. Background

CSA was selected to be the provider of their capability, experience and capacity to deliver the required learning solutions in current timeframe. CSA is capable of developing and delivering learning solutions to adult learners in electronic format (e.g. online, webinars, blended) that current industry practitioners prefer.
