**QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS**

**QUESTION 88**

Amendment 007, Q&A #51 denied transcripts as acceptable proof of education for all of the R1 education requirements. We ask that Canada please re-visit this answer. Some resources may not have access to a copy of their diploma but may have access to a transcript. A transcript is proof that is equal to a diploma, as a transcript is a copy of a student's permanent academic record, which clearly states the achievement, and includes detailed information and proof of a degree conferred to a student. Moreover, a transcript in lieu of the diploma copy is usually accepted for GoC RFPs. Please re-consider the decision to not accept a transcript in lieu of a diploma copy. We strongly believe that this is a very reasonable request.

**ANSWER 88**

Canada requires substantive evidence of successful completion demonstrated through a diploma or degree. Transcripts do not provide the same level of assurance of successful completion as do degrees or diplomas in Canada's opinion. Canada will not change this requirement as requested.

**QUESTION 89**

Rated requirement R4 for the risk management specialist, level 3 requires "*experience, within the last fifteen (15) years, using an industry standard requirements management software to assist with risk-to-requirements assessment and change impact analysis.*" As twelve years of experience are required for full points, and since there are many industry standard requirements management software tools that have been used for many years, please consider opening the window of allowed experience to "within the last twenty (20) years." This would also align this requirement with other requirements that were recently changed in amendment 007 to allow experience within the last 20 years (e.g. Q&A #55)

**ANSWER 89**

Canada will not change this requirement as requested.
