Q:

Concerning sections 3.6.1 Federal Contractors Program for Employment Equity – Bid Certification, A1.1 INTEGRITY PROVISIONS – DECLARATION OF CONVICTED OFFENCES, and A2.1 INTEGRITY PROVISIONS – REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION – do these documents have to be completed and are they applicable to this procurement in Algeria?

A:

Yes, these certifications are applicable to this procurement.

According to Section 3.6.1 Federal Contractors Program for Employment Equity – Bid Certification, by submitting a bid, the Bidder certifies that the Bidder, and any of the Bidder's members if the Bidder is a Joint Venture, is not named on the Federal Contractors Program (FCP) for employment equity "FCP Limited Eligibility to Bid" list.

According to Section A1.1 INTEGRITY PROVISIONS – DECLARATION OF CONVICTED OFFENCES, all bidders must provide with their bid, **if applicable**, the Integrity declaration form. An Integrity declaration form must be submitted **only** when the supplier, one of its affiliates or a proposed first-tier subcontractor has, in the past three years, been charged with or convicted of a criminal offence in a country other than Canada that, to the best of the supplier's knowledge and belief, may be similar to one of the listed offences in the *Ineligibility and Suspension Policy*.

According to Section A2.1 INTEGRITY PROVISIONS – REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION, the Bidder must provide the required documentation, **as applicable**, in accordance with the Ineligibility and Suspension Policy. The required documentation must be provided if Canada's Representative indicates to the Bidder that it is required.

All Bidders must sign and date the Certification Statement at the end of Attachment 1 to Part 3.
