10	"The Bidder must demonstrate experience in graphic design of large and complex reports with significant infographic content by providing examples and detailed project descriptions. The Bidder must provide a list (and web links to final products) of at least five examples of reports of similar length and complexity as the one described in Annex A, Statement of Work that it has produced." We submit this is an undue restrictive requirement and goes beyond the minimum threshold needed to choose a Report delivery agent. A request of 5 reports and two projects is unduly excessive, [] requests that aforementioned requirements should be amended [] and one report and one project as a threshold. We believe that the removal/ amendment of these requirements will provide a fair and equitable stage for all Canadian small to medium enterprise design companies to vie for the proposed contract through this solicitation and would provide the best value to Canadians in general, as well as keeping the spirit of the Canadian Competition Act in place and ensuring Canadian small to medium enterprise entrepreneurs are able to provide their services to Federal departments without undue restrictions.
