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## QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS 002

### Question 1:

Are the extended prices for line items #4-27 part of the sum to be included in the lump sum extended price for lines #1-3? Or are they to be calculated separate and apart from the Lump sum extended price 1-3 -- and then simply added into the total contract Period price at line 28?

\*\*\*My interpretation of Annex A statement of Works includes section 4.2 regarding the staff statement of work. Lines 1-3 is asking for the total lump sum of all Annex A -- I would interpret that to include the costs of lines 4-27. Yet, lines 4-27 then asks for this part of the work to be then delineated out then re-added into the previously set out total annual prices. Isn't this a double accounting of the 4.2 costs?

### Answer 1:

There is an error in Annex B. The title for lines 4-27 should read, "Task Authorization – 4.3 of Annex A – Statement of Work". Lines 4-27 are not included in the Lump Sum total. These values are estimates for evaluation purposes only for any potential extra work that will be, if required, authorized by a Task Authorization. See Amendment 2 of the solicitation.

### Question 2:

Why are the estimated number of annual hours in lines 4-27 listed as 5? For example, pursuant to section 4.2 the supervisor annual hours (@ line 4) would be 536 hours (8\*67 days). Can you please clarify? The same applies for the other staff throughout the duration of the quotation.

### Answer 2:

As per Question 1, lines 4-27 of the contract period and 2-9 of the options periods are estimates for evaluation purposes for any potential extra work that will be, if required, authorized by a Task Authorization. See Amendment 2 of the solicitation.
