This amendment 001 is issued to answer a question. This amendment is effective immediately and will form part of the contractual documents.

Questions and answers:

- Q1 Part 1 From the available documents, we do not find the information on the duration of the contract, its start date, or the terms of any possible increase process provided by Canada*. Would it be possible to obtain clarification?
- Q1 Part 2 In addition, in the "Statement of Work" section, point 5. To be provided by the Contractor, all components of the Interac Cash withdrawal service (machine, connection, bank account, etc.). Would you have a more specific description and / or reference photos of what is referred to as "machine"? Could you also send us an assessment of the number of annual transactions and their overall value, or any other form of data on this?

A1 Part 1 We have made the correction, please see RFP amendment below;

The period of the contract is for two years from the date of contract award with the option to extend the terms of the contract by up to two additional one-year (1) periods under the same condition. The Summary and Annex B "Basis of Payment" will be amended to reflect this information. Bidders will complete the Basis of Payments with their total per diem.

A1 Part 2 The "bank machine" is similar to that of retail stores where you can pay your purchases with a debit or a credit card. Clients use credit or debit cards for the transactions and these appear as purchases on the clients' statements.

It is difficult for us to give specifics as to the number of transactions and amount of money in the cash register, as these transactions remain between our clients and our service supplier. On the other hand, we can assure you that the vast majority of clients are recruits who do not have access to their bank and thus rely on this service.

The Contractor agrees to remit to Canada Revenue Agency (CRA) any amounts of HST/GST/QST paid or due.

(c) All deliverables are F.O.B. Destination, and Canadian Customs Duty included, where applicable.

(d) The Crown will not accept any travel and living expenses incurred by the Contractor as a consequence of any relocation required to satisfy the terms of the Contract.

All estimates contained in the Contract relating to travel, optional items or as-and-when-requested goods or services are included solely for the administrative purposes of Canada and do not represent a commitment on the part of Canada to exercise such options or purchase such services.
