Question:

Annex E – Mandatory Criteria - Requirements:

Proven Experience - The bidder has demonstrated its experience as the prime contractor in successfully delivering and integrating an Electronic Warfare (EW) system in a military mobile platform such as land, air, or marine vehicles in the 10 years period prior to the date of the close of the solicitation period. An EW system is a system designed to deny the opponent the advantage of access to the electromagnetic spectrum and preserve its use for friendly purposes.

Please confirm that Canada will accept experience from members of the Bidder Team against this criteria.

Answer:

The bidder can submit the experience from members of the Bidder Team as the objective evidence for the requirement on Proven Experience.

Annex D - DID PUB-001 - 10.2 - The complete final manual must be provided in bilingual (English and French) side-by-side format.

Due to the size of this project, recommend English only with rights to translate. Also recommend that COTS manuals be acceptable?

The complete final manual can be provided in English only with rights to translate, and in the Contractor's format.

Question:

Annex C - 3.5 TRAINING AND TRAINING MATERIALS

The wording in SOW 3.5 requires delivery of an (i.e., one) operator-maintainer (i.e., combined) course.

The CDRL/DID for Training Materials mentions delivery "prior to courses," and refers to "each operator's and Maintainer's course," which implies multiple separate courses.

Is Canada requiring a single, combined Operator-Maintainer course, a single iteration of separate Operator and Maintainer courses, or multiple iterations of separate Operator and Maintainer courses?

Due to the size of this project, recommend that one instance of a combined Operator-Maintainer course be held to train DND's trainers, who can then provide multiple courses to DND personnel.

Answer:

The requirement 3.5.1 in the Statement of Work is the requirement on the Contractor to conduct one combined operator-maintainer training course.
