- A.1. As needed CMHC will request the Proponent to investigate whether the trunk of a standing tree is hosting rot or not when evaluating the health of trees showing poor condition. From CMHC's understanding, there are "destructive" methods of testing and "non-destructive" methods of testing a tree to evaluate its health. The primary difference being the classes of testing equipment and the damage to the tree.
