2. Questions and Answers 1 through 3:

Question 1:

What is PSAB and what is the difference between PSAB and Non-PSAB?

Answer 1:

PSAB stands for Procurement Strategy for Aboriginal Business. The PSAB solicitation means that the procurement is being set-aside for Aboriginal consideration. As indicated in the solicitation preference will be given to Aboriginal organizations. Under PSAB, an aboriginal business must be registered with Industry Canada's Aboriginal business database.

Non-PSAB means non-Aboriginal business, meaning the supplier is not required to be registered as an Aboriginal business and will submit a bid under the Non-PSAB solicitation (21120-19-3149029-B).

Question 2:

How do I know which tender applies to me?

Answer 2:

If you are an Aboriginal business and meet the criteria to be registered with Industry Canada's Aboriginal business database, you are encouraged to submit a proposal in response to the PSAB solicitation 21120-19-3149029-A.

However, preference will be given to Aboriginal suppliers under the PSAB solicitation (21120-19-3149029-A). Bids from the Non-PSAB solicitation (21120-19-3149029-B) will only be considered if no responsive bids per institution are received for the PSAB requirement and/or if the list of PSAB suppliers by the institution has been exhausted to fulfil the need for the number of required SO's per institution.

Question 3:

What is considered an urban centre? Is there a definition or a list of recognized urban centers that CSC uses?

Answer 3:

There is no precise definition of an urban centre. The urban centres that CSC is trying to reintegrate Indigenous offenders to are mainly the ones that are closest to the 13 Aboriginal Intervention Centres identified in Annex A – Statement of Work and Annex D – Evaluation Criteria.
