Question #13

Question is around the role of hyperloop companies in this process. It is clear from the RFP that Transport Canada wishes to conduct an independent study of the feasibility of hyperloop technology. However, for that assessment to be accurate and thorough, I imagine significant input from hyperloop technology companies would be required. Therefore, would it be possible for hyperloop companies to respond to the RFP alongside or as a sub-contractor to transportation consulting firms or do you see this as a conflict of interest? If the latter, how do you envision the selected firm will engage with hyperloop companies to achieve the most comprehensive evaluation of the technology for the study?

Answer

No matter whom the bidder proposes to consult, it is anticipated that -- keeping with research 'best practices' -- they would utilize an independent peer-review process to validate the report's conclusions, recommendations, etc.
