(1) Bidders' Questions and Answers

QUESTION # 118:

Please confirm if a consortium model other than a Joint Venture is acceptable.

ANSWER # 118:

If two or more parties elect to submit a bid as a joint business enterprise, sometimes also referred to as a consortium, the joint business enterprise must meet the requirements set out in the RFP, in particular in section 2.7 Joint Venture. Canada notes that, in accordance with GC1.23 Joint and Several Liability, if a contract is awarded to a Joint Venture, all members of the Joint Venture will be jointly and severally or solitarily liable for the performance of any resulting contract.

QUESTION # 119:

If a consortium model is acceptable, can you confirm if the bid bond can be submitted by either parties of the consortium?

ANSWER # 119:

Bonds provided for Bid Security or Contract Security must be in the name of the Joint Venture, if applicable, or otherwise in the name of all members of the Joint Venture.

QUESTION # 120:

Is the following arrangement acceptable?

The Bidder may submit a tender via a consortium with a third party ("TP"). In the consortium agreement, the bidder would be the lead consortium member and would be the sole representative of the consortium in all communications with the Employer.

If the consortium's tender is successful, the contract would be between the Employer and the bidder acting on behalf of the consortium and all payments under the contract would be to the bidder receiving on behalf of the consortium.

The consortium will submit a bid bond with its tender, as well as the consortium agreement between the bidder and TP.

ANSWER # 120:

Canada will award the contract to the person or entity (or in the case of a Joint Venture, the persons or entities) as identified in Form 1- Bid Submission Form that submitted the bid with the highest combined rating of technical merit and price. Such Bidder must submit the Bid Security, please see Q&A # 119. Arrangements between the Bidder and other persons or entities that are not identified in the Bid Submission Form will be in the sole interest of the Bidder and will not form part of the contractual arrangement with Canada.

However, if two or more parties elect to submit a bid as a joint business enterprise, the joint business enterprise must meet the requirements set out in the RFP, in particular in section 2.7 Joint Venture. Note that, in accordance with GC1.23 Joint and Several Liability, if a contract is awarded to a Joint Venture, all members of the Joint Venture will be jointly and severally or solitarily liable for the performance of any resulting contract.

Annex C of the RFP (Certificate of Insurance) indicates the annual aggregate insurance limit of \$66.9M for construction insurance, including liability and OCIP insurance. Could you specify this amount, which seems to concern 3 different types of insurance?
