



Question and answer #1 of 1

Q1: Section 7.2 Part A Construction Projects describes required experience “such as embassies”. We are assuming that renovations related to a secure government-controlled access establishment would be acceptable. Can you confirm?

A1: This will be accepted provided the project meets the other requirements and the bidder clearly states in the project description what type of security upgrades were undertaken during the renovation.

Q2: Section 7.4 requires a scan of an entry visa. We have been advised by the Bangladesh High Commission that entry visas are only issued with a confirmed airline ticket, hotel dates, a work letter from the host company and a diplomatic visit letter from the Canadian Government,. Can you therefore remove this requirement and instead include it (taking into account limitations described above) with the phase 2 procurement?

A2: The requirement to provide a visa at this stage is hereby removed. Please note that a site visit will be required during the RFP stage and it is the bidders’ responsibility to apply and obtain the visas in a timely manner to meet the site visit dates.
