The purpose of Solicitation Amendment No. 002 is to:

- 1) **Revise the first page of the Request of Proposal's closing date to June 27, 2019**
 - 2) **Amend Clause 1.2(ii) – Summary to update the estimated commencement date of the contract to Jan 1, 2020.**
 - 3) **Amend Clause 2.6 - Mandatory Site Visit, to change it to an optional site visit being held on June 12, 2019**
 - 4) **Amend Clause 3.1.1 – (Mandatory) Contractor's Experience and Past Performance to change the required years of experience from two (2) consecutive years to two (2) cumulative years, within the past five (5) years.**
 - 5) **Amend Clause 3.1.2 – (Mandatory) Non-Working On-site Supervisor Expertise and Experience to change the experience requirement from two (2) consecutive years, to a minimum of two (2) cumulative years**
 - 6) **Amend Clause 4.1.1 Technical Evaluation – Mandatory Requirements to remove the mandatory Site Visit attendance.**

- (ii) The period of any resulting Contract will be for a period of two (2) years (**estimated commencement date January 1, 2020**) plus up to three (3) additional consecutive twelve (12) month periods, under the same conditions.

Canada may exercise this option at any time by sending a written notice to the Contractor **30 days** before the contract expiry date. The option may only be exercised by the Contracting Authority, and will be evidenced, for administrative purposes only, through a contract amendment.

At the time option year 2 and option year 3 are exercised, the rates in the Basis of Payment will be increased or decreased by multiplying the rates by the percentage change in "The Consumer Price Index", major components, selected sub-groups and special aggregates, provinces, Whitehorse and Yellowknife, not seasonally adjusted" ("CPI") for the appropriate province for the 12 month period ending two months before the expiration date of the current period of the contract ("period"). The CPI which will be used is published in Statistics Canada Catalogue no. 62-001-X, tables 9-1 to 9-12, for the appropriate province all-items CPI of the period as described above.
