## Amendment No. 001 to the Invitation to Qualify for the Procurement Process for Offender Computing and Technology (OCaT) Initiative for The Correctional Service of Canada

Invitation to Qualify No.	2BS-9-80034	Date	June 4, 2019
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This amendment 001 is raised to answer questions from industry:

Q1: On February 14, we responded to call for proposals #RFI 21120-198955-A. In that, we mentioned that we would be able to offer modern video games that meet the criteria of Correctional Services Canada. Seeing the Invitation to Qualify, OCAT (2BS-9-80034), we wondered if the video games we offer could be considered digital content or if there will be an Invitation to Qualify only for video games later.

R1: As per M1 of Annex A of the ITQ, Respondents must have experience delivering one of the four listed services as described in order to qualify and move to the RRR. While video games could be considered under digital content, access to digital content is not listed as one of the services. Digital content may become a requirement at a later phase of the procurement. Currently, there are no plans for a separate ITQ for digital content or video games.
