Solicitation Amendment 003

This amendment is being raised to provide responses to Requests for Clarification.

Requests for Clarification

Q27. Does the project budget of 10 million dollars include consultant fees?

A27. No, the budget of 10 million includes site work, construction cost, and design, fabrication and installation of the exhibit.

Q28. Can SI6 Security Requirement for holding a valid organization security clearance at the date of bid closing be changed to a Stage 2 requirement? If so, the proponent recognizes it is their risk to complete Stage 1 without it.

A28. Security Requirements must be met at bid closing for Phase 1.

Q29. Are the sub-consultants required to meet the security clearance requirements?

A29. Yes, sub-consultants are subject to the security requirements. For more information please see <https://www.tpsgc-pwgsc.gc.ca/esc-src/soustraitance-subcontracting-eng.html>.

Q30. Can the Stage 1 scores for all proponents (anonymous or otherwise) be disclosed at the completion of the stage, prior to Stage 2 commencing?

A30. As per General Instructions (GI) – Architectural and/or Engineering Services – Two Phase Request for Proposal (R1110T (2017-08-17)), 3.2 Phase One proposal evaluation and rating

2. Each Proponent submitting a responsive Phase One proposal is notified in writing of its Phase One Rating and, in addition, is provided with the following:

- a. an alphabetic list (normally five names) of Proponents with the highest Phase One Ratings;
- b. a list of all Phase One Ratings attained (ratings are not linked to Proponents);
- c. a date, time, and location for a Phase Two briefing meeting, if applicable;

d. the date and time for receipt of Phase Two proposals, and any supplementary instructions, terms, conditions or addenda which may be applicable to Phase Two proposal preparation and submission.

Q31. Our insurance prevents us from retaining environmental or geotechnical engineers/consultants as listed in 3.1.2. If carried on our team, their contract would need to be direct with the contracting authority.

A31. Please refer to Amendment 2, Question 25.

Q32. Please clarify, 3.2.3 Key Personnel pertains to all key personnel of both proponent and key sub-consultants, or, is it just the proponent key personnel?

A32. The Key Personnel of the Proponent will be evaluated under 3.2.3 Achievements of Key Personnel on Projects.

Q34. Are the prime and sub-consultants who prepared the Pre-Design Report permitted to submit bids on this RFP?

A34. Please refer to Amendment 2, Question 18.

Q35. We inquired about the Designated Organization Screening with CISD and were informed that after the fingerprints are sent it could take up to 3 months for results. In fairness to all applicants we would like to request an extended RFP deadline to allow for this or for the security requirements to be met at the end of the closing of the whole RFP process.

A35. The Solicitation closing date will not be extended at this time.

Q36. Do each of our consultants need the clearance before the end of the deadline of June 20? Most architects would still be deciding on their teams at this point, it seems unfair to have all potential engineers submit for security clearance. This would need to be the case if firms wanted any hope of the engineers having clearance in time.
