Questions/Answers

1. Are we able to include resumes in the technical submission as an appendix?

Resumes can be put in appendix, however, they will still count towards the page limit. See SRE 2.2.

2. Is it acceptable to have some team members participate in project meetings via tele/videoconference?

Participation via teleconference and/or videoconference is acceptable provided on-site facilities will accommodate. Proponents must ensure on-site personnel meet requirements of RS 8.

3. Is PWGSC undertaking a stakeholder outreach program? If not, is it expected the proponent will undertake one? The design brief indicates minimizing effects on the local stakeholders is a key issue; however, the scope of work regarding stakeholder engagement is not clear.

PSPC is responsible for Stakeholder engagement.

4. Are there any documents relating to the Historic designations that can be made available to proponents?

The report "2010 St. Andrews Lock and Dam Engineering Assets Assessment Heritage Value Report" is available as indicated in the list of available documents in Appendix PB-1 of tender documents.

5. Can the 2018 Bearing Monitoring Program report be provided to all proponents? This report could be critical to determine the required rehabilitation works and scope of work for the project.

Yes.

6. Can PWGSC provide a list of utilities located on the bridge?

The utilities on the bridge include a gas line, telephone line and hydro line. There are also security cameras with discreet wiring.

7. The RFP calls for deck lighting to be design to Manitoba standards. Is the sidewalk to be illuminated to the required standard as well?

Yes.

8. To enable determination of inspection access, please provide the load capacity of the dam work platforms and catwalks.

PSPC does not have the load capacities of the work platforms and catwalk. Consultant is responsible to ensure the safety of their proposed work methods. Load capacities of the work platforms and catwalk will have to be assessed if required.

9. Please confirm if PWGSC has determined the foundations / substructures are acceptable and analysis / rehabilitation of the foundations and substructures are excluded from this assignment. If not, please clarify what the intended scope of work on the foundations is. If it includes analysis, please provide any information regarding the foundations that is available (soil bore hole logs, foundation capacity information, if the foundations are anchored to bedrock, etc.).

Consultant is to identify any additional studies needed to deliver the project. See RS 2.1 c)

10. What is the frequency of rapid chloride testing required to meet Public Works standards?

Rapid Chloride Testing to be done as part of pre-design Approach Condition Survey. See RS 2.2 g)

11. Do the land surveyors have to have the M.L.S. designation?

The Consultant is responsible for ensuring all workers are qualified, certified and licensed according to federal, provincial or municipal regulations for the trade, profession or task assigned.

12. What are the Federal EA Requirements? It is clear in the RFP that CEAA applies, but not clear if a Federal EA will be required.
