This solicitation amendment has been raised to answer questions received:

Question 1

Section 31 23 22 Common Excavation was added to the specifications. There is no payment line in the form of tender. What are your intentions with this? If its incidental, we need a quantity.

Answer 1

A unit and quantity was included in the combined price schedule . Common Excavation consists of excavation, hauling, and disposal of excavated materials, and pre-existing loose rock and soil material from roadway ditch along the north side of Red Rock Parkway between approximate Station 4+000 to 4+500, and/or as directed by the Departmental Representative.

Question 2

It was discussed during site visit that roadway may require widening. Is road widening required?

Answer 2

The only road widening will including minor shoulder stripping, common excavation, subgrade preparation, grading, gravel placement, compaction and ditch cleaning at various locations. There are some areas that have no shoulders and we will make efforts to construct a 0.5 m shoulder where feasible. Unit rates have been added to cover this work.

Question 3

Is shoulder material required before guide rail installation?

Answer 3

Placement and compaction of the shoulder material can occur prior to or after guardrail installation.

Question 4

Gabion Baskets section 31 36 00 has been added. There is nothing in the drawings to indicate gabion work. And there is no payment line item for this. What is required?

Answer 4

A unit and quantity was added to the updated price shedule. This item generally includes 0.5m x 0.5m Gabions to be installed along south roadway shoulder in areas exhibiting higher erosion, at the locations directed by the department representative. Gabions to be wrapped in non-woven geotextile and placed between the new guardrail deep posts and edge of existing asphalt, with the top of gabion at 0.1m below the existing asphalt surface.

Question 5

Excavation section 31 23 33.01 has been added. What is required?

Answer 5

This section mainly covers the required minor excavation and backfilling work to install the guardrails and signs.

Question 6

Where do I find the enhanced 3.66m post in the tender. All post are explained as deep post 2.74m but no mention of enhanced.

Answer 6

A unit has been added. The enhanced deep post is described in section 34 71 13.25.

Question 7

Section 34 71 13.25 Vehicle W-Beam Guide Rail Part 1 Reference Standards 1.2.1.2 CSA G164-M – Hot Dipped Galvanizing of Irregularly Shaped Articles. CSA G164-M is obsolete as it does not meet the ASTM A123/ A653 type II coating requirements now standard with Alberta Transportation. Galvanizers do not use this method.

Answer 7

Hot dip galvanization shall be completed in accordance with the current version of the applicable Alberta Transportation Standards and Specifications.

Question 8

Section 34 71 13.25 Vehicle W-Beam Guide Rail Part 2 Products Materials 2.1.1.8 Rails & terminal elements shall be hot dipped galvanized after fabrication, in accordance with CSA-G164-M. Alberta Transportation offers galvanizing either before or after fabrication for w-beam and thrie beam. Will before fabrication be acceptable?

Answer 8

Yes, galvanizing either before or after fabrication is acceptable.

All other terms and conditions of the Invitation to Tender remain unchanged.
