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## Amendment 001

This amendment is raised to publish questions and answers, modify the TSOR, to clarify the SOW and to modify the Table of Contents of the French RFP document (in the French amendment only).

### 1. To respond to bidder questions.

**Question 1:** Why has CCG prohibited much-needed innovation from EREP Solicitation F7047-160032/D by means of Item 4.2.6.1?

**Response 1:** As touched on at the EREP: Industry Day Information and Engagement Session (F7047-180073/A) in September 2018, Canada's goal is to explore innovative technologies closer to the end of the program as there is currently no funding for R&D or developmental projects. At present, Canada's focus is on procuring existing capabilities with proven design.

**Question 2:** Why has CCG specified 50 year-old oleophilic American oil spill technology that does not meet EREP Solicitation F7047-160032/D specifications and the needs of Canada, when prohibited Canadian innovation exceeds them?

**Response 2:** Canada has a wide range of needs for Environmental Response (ER) equipment, based on a wide range of marine conditions that may be encountered in Canada's waters. No single piece of equipment will address all of these needs. As touched on at the EREP: Industry Day Information and Engagement Session (F7047-180073/A) in September 2018, and referenced in subsequent solicitation documents, Canada will be procuring a suite of between 50 to 100 distinct pieces of ER equipment, which will collectively meet Canada's full needs. The SPAS requirement reflects Canada's needs for this particular piece of the suite of equipment.

After much research and consultation, it was deemed that oleophilic skimmers are the best proven technology to support the operational requirements of the CCG for this particular piece of the ER equipment suite. Canada has left room for innovation within the parameters of the oleophilic skimmer: vendors may propose various oleophilic materials to achieve pollutant collection; vendors may also propose different designs for the oil recovery system, provided it is manufactured using oleophilic material. Oleophilic skimmers cover a broad range of commercially available equipment that have extensive in-field use. They come in various configurations and typically have various attachments to maximize the recovery of oils with various ranges of viscosities.

**Question 3:** Does the suggested adjustment in question 4 below require any change in value stated in TSOR section 4.2.12.1?

**Response 3:** TSOR section 4.2.12.1 will remain unchanged.

## **2. To modify the TSOR.**

**The TSOR was modified in response to Questions 4a and 4b.**

**Question 4a:** Is “normal load (transit)” sited in 4.31.1.4 correct or should this reference be “normal load (road transport)”?

**Question 4b:** Can the SPAS weight requirement stated in TSOR 4.31.1.4 be adjusted to max GVWR of 6,000 kg to allow for a fully compliant SPAS and trailer?

### **Response 4a & 4b:**

**Delete:** TSOR section 4.31.1.4 in its entirety and replace with sections 4.31.1.4 and 4.31.1.5.

**Insert:** **4.31.1.4.** The Gross Vehicle Weight (GVW) of the complete, outfitted trailer, laden with the SPAS in the normal load (road transit) condition must not exceed 6000 kg.

**4.31.1.5.** The GVWR must exceed the GVW of the complete, outfitted trailer, laden with the SPAS in the normal load (road transit) condition by at least 10%.

## **3. To provide a clarification to the SOW.**

Canada recognizes that page 19 and 20 are duplicate pages in the SOW. Should a contract be awarded pursuant to the RFP, this will be rectified in the SOW.

## **4. To modify the Table of Contents of the French RFP document.**

This modification applies to the French RFP document only.

**All other terms and conditions remain unchanged**
