1.	Is it possible for the contractor to have an RV parked at the bid site?	No, the RV is a possible source of emissions that can impact on measurements at the site.
2.	Is there a minimum or maximum number of days worked for the main contractor or the back-ups?	Each primary or backup operator(s) must perform the operator tasks at the site at least once per month. There is no maximum number of days as long as the minimums are met.

		The Contractor's proposed resource(s) must service the measurement site at least once per month in order to maintain their proficiency at performing the tasks.
