



6) Response to bidder questions (Q&A):

Question 12: Section 5.3, a. i and ii, lists requirements related to Professional Services Resources. The requirement does not seem to cover Professional Services, please confirm applicability of this requirement. This also possibly impacts 7.11 iv. And 7.29.



Answer 12: Professional Service Resource is not part of requirement. Please see update in International VSAT_Request for Proposal (RFP) dated 08_01_2019_AMD_001.

Question 13: Section 5.3, c. lists requirements related to OEM certification, as we understand it, hardware is not being provided to the customer, please confirm applicability of this requirement.

Answer 13: Please see update in International VSAT_Request for Proposal (RFP) dated 08_01_2019_AMD_001.

Question 14: Section 5.3 d. lists requirements related to the supply of software and the requirement to supply certification and/or authorization, however as we understand it, software is not being provided to the customer, please confirm applicability of this requirement.

Answer 14: Please see update in International VSAT_Request for Proposal (RFP) dated 08 01 2019 AMD 001.

Question 15: Section 7.6 c) has a requirement of NATO SECRET, but the SRCL has a requirement of NATO Confidential, please confirm the correct security requirement.

Answer 15: The SRCL was reflects that NATO Secret personnel security clearance (10a) is required to access NATO Confidential. There is no changes required. However that escort clause is missing on the English version. Please see update in International VSAT_Request for Proposal (RFP) dated 08_01_2019_AMD_001.

Question 16: Section 7.28 lists requirements for training in accordance with the Annex A, training was not found as part of Annex A, please confirm.

Answer 16: Training is not part of requirement. Please see update in International VSAT_Request for Proposal (RFP) dated 08_01_2019_AMD_001.

Question 17: Annex A, 2.7 and 2.9.4. In 2.7, the term TST is being used and in 2.9.4 the term TNT is being used, are these meant to be the same value for any given month? Please describe the difference in use between the 2.

Answer 17: The terms TST and TNT are the same value for any given month.


Question 18: Annex A, 2.7.1.1. In Section 2.6.1, the availability of services is listed as 99.8%, but in payment credits section 2.71.1, no indication of when the credits start to apply. Are the credits meant to be when the availability of services target is not met? Please confirm.

Answer 18: Yes, the credit would be applied only when the availability of service target is not met.

Question 19: Annex A, 3.3.2.1 lists requirements for Type 1 and Type 3 satellite space segment, but in 3.1.1.1, only Type 3 is listed. Please confirm.

Answer 19: Sections 3.3.2.1 and 4.3.2.1 have been modified in the SOW to reflect the need to supply Type 3 service only. Furthermore, the pricing tables have been modified to provide pricing for Type 3 satellite space segment only.

Question 20: Annex A 4.3.2.1 lists requirements for Type 1 and Type 3 satellite space segment, but in 4.1.1.1, only Type 3 is listed. Please confirm.



Answer 20: Sections 3.3.2.1 and 4.3.2.1 have been modified in the SOW to reflect the need to supply Type 3 service only. Furthermore, the pricing tables have been modified to provide pricing for Type 3 satellite space segment only.

Question 21: Annex B1 and Annex B2, pricing sheets has sheets for Primary Beam and Secondary beam. There is no mention of these terms in Annex A, what is the requirement?

Answer 21: The primary beam is defined as the beam with the best characteristics (satellite EIRP and G/T) that would be offered first when a service is requested from the contractor. If the space segment is not available on the primary beam, then space segment on the secondary beam can be offered to meet the service requirement. The SOW has been amended to include the definition of Primary and Secondary beams.

Question 22: Section 7.35 b) talks about transition of services for UHF Satellite Service, should this state C & Ku-band satellite services?

Answer 22: Section 7.35 of the RFP has been changed to correct the wording and remove the reference to UHF Satellite Service.

Question 23: Annex A 2.3.3.3, the MSDI for Regular Priority Service delivery is defined in business days, but the Express Priority service delivery is defined in calendar days, please confirm.

Answer 23: The MSDI for regular priority service delivery is expressed in business days while the MSDI for express priority service is expressed in calendar days.

Question 24: Annex A 2.3.3.3, how many times would the Express Priority Service delivery clause be invoked and in what situations and for what services specifically in the SOW?

Answer 24: The request for Express Priority Service is invoked in cases when the requirement calls for it

Question 25: Annex A 3.4.1.7, do you have specific security requirements at the teleport against unauthorized access?


Answer 25: No, there is no specific requirement, as long as access to the Teleport is secure. With respect to the security requirements at the teleport, clause 3.4.1.8 in SOW has been amended. Also please refer to Form 3 – Substantiation of technical compliance with respect to the teleport requirement.

Question 26: With a closing date in August, we would need an extension of 4 weeks, can this be accommodated?

Answer 26: We agree to an extension of the closing date to Monday August 26th, 2019

Question 27: In the RFP, the Comtech CDM-600 is being requested. The CDM-600 is no longer produced by Comtech, would SSC accept an equivalent, currently produced modem like the CDM-625 which can support both serial and IP?

Answer 27: Yes, SSC accepts the Comtech CDM-625 as an equivalent. All references to the Comtech CDM-600 in the SOW, and in the pricing tables have been changed to reflect the Comtech CDM-625 modem.



Question 28: In the RFP, there is also a possibility to provide other modems, does SSC know in which direction their customers will be going seeing that IP is the new standard? Which modems might be required under this possible contract?

Answer 28: If a new type of satellite modem is required, SSC will advise the contractor that a new type of satellite modem would be provided to the Contractor for installation at the Teleport to be compatible with the service.

Question 29: We request further clarification regarding the NATO classification with regard to the SRCL document. We have reviewed the SRCL document and we have also spoken with the CISD and it is not clear if this precludes the use of non-NATO countries from providing ground facilities or spacecraft to support the missions outlined in the RFP. Please clarify further or direct us to other sources where we can obtain a specific response.

Answer 29: The bidder must abide to conditions of the Security Requirements Check List (SRCL) form as part of this bid solicitation for the Space Segment, Teleport, Terrestrial Backhaul as well as other related facilities.

Question 30: Due to the scope of this RFP (worldwide service request) and the amount of resources needed to provide a through response we request an extension of 45 days be granted to allow us sufficient time to complete the proposal.

Answer 30: We agree to an extension of the closing date to Monday August 26th, 2019

Question 31: In the RFP you request Comtech CDM 600 modems. These modems are no longer available and are not supported by Comtech. Please clarify if we can use a comparable modem (i.e. CDM 625A) that would be backward compatible with the legacy modems currently deployed.

Answer 31: Please refer to the answer to question 27.

Question 32: The standard modem would support the link budgets requested in the RFP. Any optional features would be subject to an additional charge. Please concur or otherwise clarify.


Answer 32: If the link design for a specific service calls for options that are not available on the standard modem that is part of the modem service, SSC would make an arrangement for Teleport service using the required modem to meet the needs of the link design.

Question 33: Section 5.3, c. lists requirements related to OEM certification, as we understand it, hardware is not being provided to the customer, please confirm applicability of this requirement.

Answer 33; Section 5.3c has been removed from the RFP. (Here PVR to remove as section 5.3c is part of the front end of the RFP.)

Question 34: Section 5.3 d. lists requirements related to the supply of software and the requirement to supply certification and/or authorization, however as we understand it, software is not being provided to the customer, please confirm applicability of this requirement.

Answer 34; Section 5.3d has been removed from the RFP. (Here PVR to remove as section 5.3d is part of the front end of the RFP.)



Question 35: In Annex B1 and Annex B2 – Instructions, there is a statement in the Notes under Note 2 that refers to 4.3 (d) in the main body of the RFP, we are unable to find that clause. Please confirm correct reference.

Answer 35: The reference is 4.3 (b). The pricing tables, Annex B1 and Annex B2 have been corrected accordingly.

Question 36: In RFP, section 4.2, "Subject to the mandatory compliance, the compliance bids will be further evaluated on rated criteria to determine the overall quality of the technical proposal. This criteria are identified in Annex E.", Annex E is the claim for exchange rate fluctuation, please confirm reference.

Answer 36: Response: The reference is Annex D – Technical and Financial Evaluation Methodology. This document is now titled Annex D and not Annex E.

Question 37: SSC's request for proposal for Satellite Services in International VSAT C and Ku Band issued July 5, 2019 requires extensive technical resources and is very time consuming if a bidder wishes to provide a compliant bid response that meets all the Mandatory Primary and Secondary coverage as well as the Non-Mandatory Primary and Secondary coverage between C-Band and the Mandatory Primary and Secondary coverage between Canada and Secondary coverage between Canada and 5 separate Satellite Coverage zones at Ku-Band, the bidder therefore requests an extension to September 23, 2019.

Answer 37: We agree to an extension of the closing date to Monday August 26th, 2019

ALL OTHER INFORMATION RELATED TO THIS SOLICITATION, REMAINS UNCHANGED
