THE PURPOSE OF THIS AMENDMENT IS TO GIVE EFFECT TO THE FOLLOWING CHANGE:

1. In clause "R2710T GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS - CONSTRUCTION SERVICES - BID SECURITY REQUIREMENTS (GI) (2019-05-30)", remove section "GI06 (2015-02-25) REGISTRY AND PRE-QUALIFICATION OF FLOATING PLANT" in its entirety and replace with the following:

- **GI06 (2015-02-25) REGISTRY AND PRE-QUALIFICATION OF FLOATING PLANT**

Dredges or other floating plant to be used in the performance of the Work must be on Canadian registry. For dredges or other floating plant that are not of Canadian make or manufacture, the Bidder must obtain a certificate of qualification from Industry Canada as described in the Floating Plant Appendix of the Bid and Acceptance Form, and this certificate must accompany the bid. Plant so qualified by Industry Canada may be accepted on this project.

The volume to be paid for shall be the total number of cubic metres of materials (common material, rock and larger boulder) removed and disposed in accordance with the drawings and specification, as calculated by the Consultant determined by surveys included in the specifications. Contractor should include excavation tolerances within the calculated quantities.
- d) Work included in the Unit Price represents all work described in the Summary of Work document (Including but not limited to Mob/Demob, testing, inspections, travel, etc.).
