This amendment to bid solicitation no. 5000046107 is to address the enquiries received.

Answers to Questions

Q1. For the rated criteria R3 (see page 18 of the English PDF document) - the bid requires "four (4) reference projects should be presented for each topic." Does it mean the bid requires 12 Reference projects as there are three topics mentioned below: Topic 1, Topic 2 and Topic 3?

A1. Four (4) reference projects should be presented for each topic.
This could result in a total of 12 reference projects submitted as part of rated criteria R3. However, a reference project can be used for multiple topics, if applicable, and reduce the number of reference projects submitted. For example, a reference project could be listed as satisfying both Topic 1 and Topic 2 experience requirements. The Bidder should clearly demonstrate the applicability of the project to each of the topics.

Q2. For the same rated criteria, in the NOTE below - it is mentioned "no differentiation between new projects and expansions/modifications" - please clarify the above

A2. Rated criterias R3.1 and R3.2 award points for demonstrating experience with multiple project types, as listed under R3. For example,

- o If 2 of the reference projects submitted consist of a hydro electricity generation project and a fossil fuel electricity generation project, this would count as 2 project types. They could be new or expansion projects.

- o However, if 2 of the reference projects submitted consist of a new hydro electricity generation project and an expansion hydro electricity generation project, this would count as 1 project type.

All other terms and conditions of the Bid Solicitation remain the same.
