Amendment 005 is being issued to provide an answer to submitted questions and modify numbering under Schedule B. Questions #1 to #10 were answered in previous Solicitation amendments.

QUESTION #11:

Under 3.2 Section I: Technical Bid, section (i) the RFP allows that “Proposed resources (CPT) may be employees of the Bidder or employees of a subcontractor, or these individuals may be independent contractors to whom the Bidder would subcontract a portion of the Work”.

Under 3.2 Section I: Technical Bid, section (d) the RFP requires that “Where the bid must include a description of reference projects, a project must have been completed by the Bidder itself and cannot include the experience of any proposed subcontractor or any affiliate of the Bidder”.

Since the RFP requires that reference projects be provided both for corporate experience and for CPT resource experience, and since the RFP allows the use of subcontracted CPT resources to be key members of the bidder’s corporate team, it is hereby respectfully requested that reference projects for subcontracted CPT resources be permitted as reference corporate projects under M1, M2, and R2.

ANSWER #11:

M1, M2 and R2 are assessing the corporate experience of the bidding entity and may include projects for which members of the proposed CPT participated. R3 is assessing the experience of the individual CPT resources, and as such RFP 3.2 Section I: Technical Bid (d) is not intended to apply to projects submitted under R3. The same project(s) may be used to satisfy more than one criterion, provided they meet the requirements of the criterion. 3.2 Section I: Technical Bid (d) is amended as follows:

At Page 9 of 35: 3.2 Section I: Technical Bid

DELETE:

(d) Reference Projects: Where the bid must include a description of reference projects, a project must have been completed by the Bidder itself and cannot include the experience of any proposed subcontractor or any affiliate of the Bidder.

For project submitted in response the a Mandatory Technical Criteria, if the quantity of project submitted exceed the amount stipulated in the criteria, the project will be evaluated in the order they were submitted and any extraneous projects will not be evaluated.

INSERT:

(d) Reference Projects: For Mandatory Technical Criteria – M1, M2 and Rated Technical Criteria – R2, where the bid must include a description of reference projects, a project must have been completed, or led by, the Bidder itself.

For projects submitted in response to the Mandatory Technical Criteria, if the quantity of projects submitted exceeds the amount stipulated in the criteria, the projects will be evaluated in the order they were submitted and any extraneous projects will not be evaluated.

QUESTION #12:

Further to Answer # 9 issued through Amendment 004 on August 16, 2019, can you please clarify whether Supplemental Project Resources are being evaluated through the PMP in the Technical Bid?

ANSWER #12:

The PMP submitted through R1 should identify, in accordance with R1a and R1b, the number, type of resource (CPT or Supplemental), area of expertise/specialization, level of effort, etc., required to undertake the Work activities. Bidders are not required to propose specific individuals or demonstrate experience for Supplementary Project Resources as part of this bid solicitation. Qualifications and experience of the Supplemental Project Resources will only be assessed after contract award as part of the Task Authorization process.

Once the contract is awarded, Canada and the Contractor will discuss all the activities to be completed including the required Supplemental Project Resources to be engaged and assessed through the Task Authorization process. Updates to the PMP including Supplemental Project Resources will form part of the monthly Project Progress Reports.

To clarify Supplemental Resources vs Other Resources, Annex “A” Statement of Work, Section 7 – Supplemental Project Resources is amended as follows:

At Annex A – 7 Supplemental Project Resources

DELETE: Sub-section 7.1 in its entirety.

INSERT:

7.1 In order to support the CPT in performing the Work, or to perform Work authorized under a Task Authorization, the Contractor may supplement the CPT with qualified individuals on an "as-and-when-required" basis through the Task Authorization. These Supplemental Project Resources will include, but are not limited to, the following:

- a) Senior Marine Systems Engineer;
- b) Senior Electrical Systems Engineer;
- c) Draftsperson;
- d) Cost Estimation Specialist;
- e) Marine Procurement Specialist;
- f) Other Resources proposed in the PMP that may be required to complete key Work Activities including, but not limited to the following:
 - i. Intermediate Engineers (Marine, Naval Architect, Marine Systems) and Technologists (Naval Architecture, Marine Systems);
 - ii. Marine Inspectors and Technicians; and
 - iii. Any other resources that may be required to complete key Work activities.
