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**Question 1:** As per your tender document W8486-195929/B, in regards to item 4, could you please verify if PE9088 is the correct part number for this item or is it an error?

**Answer 1:** This is the correct part number. The Technical Authority will accept the following part numbers as equivalent to PE9088:  
- 21-194-0  
- RFA-8342

**Question 2:** Item 4 - NSN 5935-20-004-4358 - the P/N PE9088 referenced is not catalogued or recognized against this NSN. PE9088 is catalogued under NSN 6625-01-587-1797. Will DND consider amendment subj RFP with the correct NSN for item 4?

**Answer 2:** The NSNs are used for internal cataloguing purposes only. As stated in the RFP, bidders are to use the part numbers to bid. The Technical Authority will accept the following part numbers as equivalent to PE9088:

**Question 3:** Will DND consider amendment subj RFP with changing the delivery date to "Best Delivery Date offered"?

**Answer 3:** The delivery date will not be changed to "Best Delivery Date offered" however it has been amended to February 28, 2020.

**Question 4:** We respectfully request that this bid be extended by 2 weeks.

**Answer 4:** The closing date has been extended to September 09, 2019.

**Question 5:** Paragraph 1.5 Canadian Content. All the products that you wish to be supplied are from manufacturers located outside of Canada. This requirement should be removed in order to be fair to all bidders.

**Answer 5:** As per section 5.1.1 of the RFP, the requirement is conditionally limited to Canadian Content. The requirement will not be removed since it is only conditional. As per the Supply Manual, the definition of Conditionally Limited is as follows (<https://buyandsell.gc.ca/policy-and-guidelines/supply-manual/section/3/130>) :

### 3.130. Canadian Content Policy

- d.B Conditionally Limited: the bid solicitation or request for standing offers will be conditionally limited when the contracting officer is uncertain whether two or more suppliers of Canadian goods and/or services exist.
  - a. Certifications for competitive procurement conditionally limited to Canadian goods and/or services are provided in the SACC Manual, under clause numbers: [A3061T](#), [A3062T](#), [A3063T](#), [A3065T](#), [A3066T](#) and [A3069T](#) for bid solicitations; and [M3061T](#), [M3062T](#), [M3063T](#), [M3065T](#), [M3066T](#) and [M3069T](#) for requests for standing offers.
  - b. The bidder will be required to submit the Canadian content certification with the bid.

As well as,

- e.B. If the procurement process was conditionally limited to Canadian goods and/or services, the contracting officer will determine, first, if there are two or more bids with a valid Canadian content certification. In that event, the evaluation will be limited to the bids with the certification; otherwise, all bids will be evaluated. If the bids with a valid certification are later declared non-responsive or withdrawn, and, and after such there are less than two responsive bids with a valid certification of Canadian goods and/or services, the evaluation will continue among those responsive bids which contain a valid certification. If all bids with a valid certification are subsequently found to be non-responsive or withdrawn, then all other bids received will be evaluated. (See SACC Manual clause [A3070T](#).)
