

SOLICITATION NUMBER: 5000047745 - AMENDMENT 001

This amendment is raised to issue Questions and Answers Series 001 and revise the RFSO as per below.

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS 001:

Q1. For the distance training under Stream 5, would CNSC be open to the idea of using a methodology comprised of a mix of self-learning and tutoring?

A1. Yes.

Q2. For the distance training under Stream 5, would it be possible to use a program based on PFL2 but which has been modified in order to improve it?

A2. Yes, provided the program is based on PFL2. This would also be acceptable for the other streams.

Q3. Would CNSC consider revising the required number of hours in M1.1, as 36,000 hours in the last 8 years seems quite high?

A3. Yes, the required number of hours has been reduced. Please see Amendment 001 to the RFSO below.

Q4. Can you confirm that the selection methodology for Streams 1 through 5 is <u>not</u> lowest hourly rate?

A4. That is correct. The selection methodology for Streams 1 through 5 is 70% on the technical merit and 30% on the price as outlined in the RFSO. This puts less emphasis on the price, as it is important to the CNSC to achieve best value through a combination of the quality of the teaching and the commensurate price.
