C. Questions & Answers

Q1 Does damage to the fence and path at Red Rock Canyon need to be repaired?

A1 No. The fence and pathway at Red Rock Canyon is scheduled for rehabilitation/replacement in 2020. Damage to this infrastructure caused by the contractor will not require to be prepared. However, any damage to the pedestrian bridges caused by the contractor's work shall be repaired at the cost of the contractor.

Q2 Can ashes produced from timber burning operations be left on site?

A2 No. All ashes shall be removed from site and properly disposed.

Q3 Is camping allowed at Crandell Mountain Campground?

A3 No.

Q4 In accordance with Specification for Hazardous Tree Removal Section 01 11 00 clause 1.3.2.4 trees may only be disposed of via burning or disposed off site. What size of tree is small enough to be mowed down as part of the brushing operation?

A4 Any tree with trunk measuring 25mm in diameter or smaller at the base is permitted to be mowed down as part of the brushing operation. Please note that all debris created from the brushing operation is required to be disposed in accordance with Specification for Hazardous Tree Removal Section 01 11 00 clause 1.3.2.4 (ie. burning or disposed off site)

Q5 What is the load rating on the bridge entering Crandell Mountain Campground?

A5 The bridge located on the main (east) access road entrance into Crandell Mountain Campground has a limit of 28t, 32t and 43t for single truck, semi-tractor and b-train configurations respectively. Related specification section for Hazardous Tree Removal Section 1.5.6 is deleted.

Q6 Because there is no delineated line for tree removal, also citing The Waterton Lakes National Park, best management practices, state “hazard trees must be removed 1.5 tree lengths from infrastructure”. What is the actual specs “hitting the road” or as per stated, 1.5 tree lengths from infrastructure (roads and building)?

A6 The above spec applies only at Red Rock Canyon where the contractor will have an individual who is properly certified exercise judgement based on the guidelines stated within the BMP.

Q7 Do the trees over 125mm in diameter need to be cut in to 300mm logs (firewood)? If not, how many trees overall, over 125mm, need to be fire-wooded?

A7 No trees are required to be cut into firewood.

Q8 Under favourable conditions (dry or frozen) will a feller buncher or excavator be acceptable machinery off the hard surface or does one need to assume that we can not use machinery, and all work is done by hand off hard surface?

A8 Tracked machinery such as a feller buncher or excavator is acceptable to be used off the hard surface.

D. Tender Package Revisions

1. The unit price table for the Contaminated Sites Work has been replaced in its entirety and replaced with a single lump sum bid item. Please note this change in the revised bid table included in this addendum.
2. The hazard tree removal at Red Rock Canyon will be paid as unit price per tree instead of lump sum. The estimated number of trees to be removed is 450. Please note this change in the revised bid table included in this addendum.
3. The upper bridge at Red Rock Canyon is closed to all access due to structural concerns. The other two lower trail bridges crossing the creek are permitted to be used by the contractor but shall not be crossed using motorized equipment.
4. Specification for Hazardous Tree Removal Section 01 11 00 clause 1.3.2.4.3 shall be deleted and replaced with the following “At Red Rock Canyon and within the Wildlife Corridor only, trees shall be felled and limbed and left in place on the forest floor.”
5. All debris produced from Close Cut Clearing (including brush, grasses and shrubs) shall be disposed in accordance with specification for Hazardous Tree Removal Section 01 11 00 clause 1.3.2.4 (ie. burning or disposed off site)
6. Drawing “Site 8.2: Coppermine Day Use Area Remediation Plan” mistakenly references the “concrete vault” as a “concrete pad”. The vault is to be removed and disposed, including any contents.

7. In several instances on the drawings concrete slabs (and pads) are indicated to be assumed 0.15m thick. The true thickness or depth of concrete is not known and variances are to be expected. Removal of concrete up to 0.45m thick shall be considered to be within the scope of work and incidental to the contract.

8. The following specifications and figure are revised and replaced as part of this addendum:
