**A. QUESTION AND RESPONSE**

**QUESTION 1:** "From TN Manual Section 9 - (dated 2017-12-21)

"USE OF GOVERNMENT VEHICLES BY NON-GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES - CONTRACTORS

1. Individuals authorized to operate a DND vehicle while on official business may be exposed to potential liability for property damage, including damage to other drivers, personal injury, and other third-party claims.
2. When DND vehicles are operated by non-government employees, such as contractors, the level of risk must be identified in their contract and a copy of the contract must be made available to the Transportation Authority's and local JAG for verification before issuing a DND 404.
3. For situations where contractors may be required to use DND vehicles, there are four basic options available to DND to ensure appropriate use of insurance and the appropriate approach to risk management:

Will the Crown in accordance with the clearly stated direction from its own Transportation Manual allow the contracting company to use government vehicle for the purpose of Class 3 testing of contractors?

**RESPONSE 1:** DND will not allow the contracting company to use DND vehicles for Class 3 testing. As a result DND is removing the requirement for instructors to have a Class 3 provincial driver's License to teach on a class 3 equivalent vehicle. They need to be qualified the vehicle and qualified to instruct in accordance with the TP the same as military personnel.

**B. CHANGES TO SOLICITATION:**

At Annex "A" Statement of Work, section 3.5.1 Instructors

Delete: (c) in its entirety

Insert:

(c) Instructors must hold appropriate provincial driver's license equivalent to New Brunswick class 5. If the instructors is required to start training on a DND vehicle that is not equivalent to a provincial driver's license for class 5 no upgrade of provincial driver's license is required, however the instructors must attend a course on the Military vehicle following the course material as spelled out within the QS/TP for that vehicle. When qualified and meeting the prerequisites as an instructor for that vehicle and it is on their DND driver Permit (DND 404) they then can instruct on that vehicle.
