Part 1 – Questions and Answers

Question No. 14

In the recent response for question #8, Canada responded with:

Section 4.1.2.5 is a requirement that after contract award must be met by the solution provided by the successful Contractor by the dates specified in the Milestone Table, **it is not a qualifying factor for the Bid Solicitation**. The Bid Solicitation remains unchanged.

The statement "**it is not a qualifying factor for the Bid Solicitation**" seems to contradict M-2.2 which states:

"The Bidder must provide proof from the RCMP Departmental Security Branch (DSB) via an approved Threat and Risk Assessment that they are authorized to submit fingerprints electronically from urban, rural and remote locations in Canada. **This proof must be provided and be in effect at time of bid closing.**"

Can Canada confirm that M-2.2 remains unchanged?

Answer No. 14

Section 4.1.2.5 requires that the Secure Fingerprinting Component of the Solution provided under the contract be approved by the RCMP to allow electronic submission of digital fingerprints securely from any urban, rural and remote location across Canada. M-2.2 requires that Bidders provide proof from the RCMP Departmental Security Branch (DSB) that they are authorized to submit fingerprints electronically from urban, rural and remote locations in Canada at time of bid closing. The proof provided at time of bid closing, to be compliant with M-2.2, may not necessarily be with the Bidder's proposed Livescan system. M-2.2 remains unchanged.

Question No. 15

Related to M-2.1: "The Bidder must provide proof from the RCMP that their proposed Livescan system including their proposed Fingerprint Acquisition Profile (FAP) mobile device is vendor certified to the most current version of the RCMP 1.7.8. ICD. This proof must be provided and be in effect by October 25, 2019 or the bid will be declared non responsive."

Can Canada confirm that the latest RCMP ICD version is still 1.7.8 Revision 1.6?

Answer No. 15

Revision 1.6 is the current version of RCMP 1.7.8 ICD. Please see Bid Solicitation Change #11, #12, #13 and #14 below.

Question No. 19

Due to the changing requirements and complexity of the submission required, would the Crown consider a one week extension?

Canada is not considering extension requests for this solicitation.

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Part 2 – Bid Solicitation Changes

#11 At Annex A, Section 4.3.6:

Delete: Section 4.3.6 in its entirety.

And Replace With:

4.3.6 The Contractor's system solution (hardware and software) must be certified for NPS-NIST-ICD compliancy before the system will be permitted to submit specific transactions as defined in the NPS-NIST-ICD 1.7.8 revision 1.6 or more recent, (Interface Control Document). As a prerequisite to RCMP scanner certification, the scanner must be listed on the FBI Certified Products List, <https://www.fbibiospecs.cjis.gov/Certifications>.

#12 At Annex A, Section 4.3.7:

Delete: Section 4.3.7 in its entirety.

And Replace With:

4.3.7 Every transaction (NIST file) submitted to the RTID System must adhere to the ANSI/NIST Standard and NPS-NIST-ICD 1.7.8 revision 1.6 or more recent specification to be considered valid. In order for the RTID System to accept and process a NIST file, it must be both well-formed and valid.

#13 At Attachment 4.1 to Part 4 – Technical Evaluation Criteria, M-2.1:

Delete: M-2.1 in its entirety.

And Replace With:

M-2.1 The Bidder must provide proof from the RCMP that their proposed Livescan system including their proposed Fingerprint Acquisition Profile (FAP) mobile device is vendor certified to RCMP NPS-NIST-ICD version 1.7.8. revision 1.6. This proof must be provided and be in effect at time of bid closing.

#14 At Attachment 4.3 to Part 4 – Demonstration, Section 2. End to End Reliability Status Use Case/Scenario, sub-heading Fingerprinting Component:

Delete: the first paragraph in its entirety.

And Replace With:

After the TBS Web form has been submitted, the data from the web form must be available to the Bidder's RCMP-certified Livescan system. This Livescan system must be able to import this demographic data into the Livescan solution and then perform the fingerprinting. The fingerprint scanner must be a mobile FAP 50 or FAP 60 and be the one proposed by the Bidder and certified by the RCMP to NPS-NIST-ICD 1.7.8 revision 1.6 or more recent. The data populated in the Livescan system must be the same as the data keyed into the TBS Web application form.

ALL OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS REMAIN UNCHANGED
