2	Wharf details are needed to accurately calculate the types of anchorages and also the lengths of chains needed for hanging the fenders. Because these are floating fenders, ideally we need to know the water levels as well?	<p>These foam filled floating fenders are used afloat between vessels at our facility and the wharf walls. See Requirement 1.2.1 "There is no requirement on the part of the Vendor for installation of the fender or provision of any installation hardware." They are floating at all times not attached to the wharf wall with chains. We haven't ordered chain connections. We secure the floating fenders in position with rope lines attached to the shackle points on each end of the fender.</p>
3	On occasion, these types of fenders are installed with backing panels (typically low friction polyethylene material). This might be the case here as tyre nets are not required. The specification states that the fenders will "be located against poured concrete jetty (wharf) faces". 4	2.4.3.1 Fender Skin, you have specified that the outer skin must be 25mm thick, which would be correct if you were purchasing standard capacity fenders. With the Super High Capacity Fenders, the skin thickness should be a minimum 50mm thick in order to resist the higher reaction forces of the fender.	<p>Canada agrees. The skin thickness must be not less than 50 mm thick</p>

5	2.4.2.1.1 Foam Core density, you have called for is 3.3 to 6.5 lbs/ft3, which again is suitable for a standard capacity fender, however for Super High Capacity, the foam density must be a minimum of 11lbs/ft3.	Canada agrees. The foam density shall be not less than 11lbs/ft3.
6	2.3.3.2.1 Elastomer, you have called out 100% PTMEG which is an elastomer that is used by only one specific foam fender manufacturer, therefore essentially creating a "sole-source" contract through this part of the solicitation. The elastomer that we use is a proprietary system with comparable properties to the PTMEG, though, in our experience and opinion, provides superior performance and durability. I would request that you change Annex A- Requirement to include "or equal".	Canada agrees.
