## Annex A-1.

Clarification of Appendix “A, section 3.2.2 of the SOW on Other Measures:

Transport Canada is expecting the bidder to conduct a survey of whale watching companies and communities on the impacts of the 2019 Interim Order measures, and obtain feedback on how these measures could be improved for 2020. The population covered is the whale watching companies and communities impacted by the *Interim Order for the Protection of Killer Whales in the Waters of Southern British Columbia* which includes an approach distance provision and prohibitions against entering three Interim Sanctuary Zones. As well, whale watching companies would also be surveyed on the impacts of the Sustainable Whale Watching Agreement. At a minimum, communities surveyed would need to include the Gulf Islands (Pender and Saturna), as well as communities that may have been impacted by the Interim Sanctuary Zone at Swiftsure Bank.
