Revised Question and Answer #45**

The response to question #45 has been revised.

**Question #45:**

To clarify the response offered to Question #21, is the voice of someone other than the requestor 'personally-identifying' (such that all voices that are not the requestor's voice should be muted), or only personally-identifying information spoken by anyone (such that all voices are to remain unmuted, except those parts that reveal personally-identifying information)? We're asking whether one's voice is considered private information, or only things spoken like names and addresses.

**Revised Response #45:**

The voice itself is not typically described as personal information. If it is determined that a voice is considered private, then the redacting would probably be done manually.
