Further to the above-mentioned Invitation to Tender, this **Addendum #2** is to advise potential bidders of the following answers to Bidders questions received to date:

Question #1: The electrical work to be completed on the rear tower is to be completed by us or the CCG, including changing the light fixtures. Also, in the SOW, section $024116 \, \text{Part} \, 3 - 3.4 \, \text{Mentions}$ demolition of rear unit not to commence until new tower is constructed and commissioned. Is that the case? My understanding is that the rear tower is to be demolished before construction of the new rear tower?

Answer #1: The removal of the existing electrical equipment and cutting power to the tower is to be completed by the contractor but the installation of the new electrical equipment will be completed by CCG after tower installation. Lines 3.1.3 and 3.1.4 of Section 024116 shall be omitted, the existing rear tower must be removed before installation of the new tower can take place.

Question #2: The paint on the tower does it contain lead?

Answer#2: Based on experience handling towers in this region of similar age, it should be assumed that the paint on the tower contains lead and appropriate measures should be taken to limit it's dispersion to the environment.

Question #3: Has [the paint] been sampled?

Answer #3: No, the tower's paint has not been tested.
