This Solicitation Amendment 001 is raised to incorporate the Q&A's during the mandatory bidders' conference, to incorporate responses to additional questions received, and to incorporate the Mandatory Bidders' Conference Attendee List.

All other terms and conditions remain unchanged.

Q&A's during the mandatory bidders' conference dated November 12th, 2019 at 11:00am:

Q1.) In the provided SRCL Annex B it states that unscreened personnel may work while on the harbour – do all personnel have to have reliability status on the project or may unscreened personnel be used for portions of the work while on the harbour? We requested that PPM supply this question in writing.

A1.) In practice on other DND projects we have allowed unscreened personnel to work on projects on the harbour as long as they are not accessing secure zones. The harbour is considered a reception zone for DND, and therefore unscreened personnel are permitted to work there. However, the company still has to maintain the DOS clearance.

Q2.) What do you consider to be the scope of suppliers for Appendix 3, does it include all subcontractors such as tugs, material suppliers, surveyors.

A2.) Appendix 3 – Listing of Subcontractors and Suppliers, includes the list of all subcontractors and suppliers applicable for performing any division of the Work as identified in the table. In this case, there is only one (1) division applicable, which is Division 35 37 10 – Material Placement.

Q3.) Does Annex B (SRCL) need to be attached as a mandatory bid requirement at bid close?

A3.) No, bidders are not required to submit Annex B with their bid submission. PSPC will verify that the Bidder's DOS is cleared at bid closing.

Q4.) In SRE3 Section 1.2 Bidder's Team Experience can current projects be used as example projects?

A4.) Yes, however only the portions of the project complete by Oct 31, 2019 can be submitted – bidders should make it clear in the bid submission what aspects of the project have been completed by October 31, 2019.

Q5.) Why does the sand have to be washed?

A5.) As per Specification Section 35 37 10 Material Placement 2.1 the Material Type 1 is required to be a clean, fine grained river sand material, free of organic material, as similar in nature to the native sediment within the Project Site (sand) as practicable and must conform to the 2009 Platinum Edition (Volume II) of the MMCD, in addition the contractor is required to wash Material Type 1 to meet the gradation requirements or to remove excess highly suspendable fines prior to placement to help comply with the required gradations, as well as water quality monitoring requirements as described in the EMP. The primary purpose of material washing is to reduce turbidity during material placement.

Q6.) Confirming that only three contractors have met the mandatory requirement of attendance at the mandatory bidders meeting?

A6.) Correct. Present in the mandatory bidders conference were Sanexan, PPM, and JJM.

Responses to Additional Questions received:

Q7.) Part B, Item a) of Annex B says the Personnel Security Screening Level required is "Reliability Status". Part B, Item b) of Annex B says unscreened personnel may be used for portions of the work. Further, it says that unscreened persons may only access public/reception zones.

- a. Can PWGSC please clarify where the "public/reception zones" are as they relate to this project and Government property in Esquimalt Harbor.

A7.) The public/reception zone includes Esquimalt Harbour.

Q8.) Our company currently holds Reliability Status however we have no personnel with Reliability Status screening. We have applications pending however it has been months in the Governments system. Can the contractor use unscreened personnel for this contract if the contractor has Reliability Status and personnel screening applications are pending?

A8.) As per RFP Section SC01 Industrial Security Related Requirements. At time of bid close the Bidder must hold a valid Designation Organization Screening (DOS). The Bidder personnel requiring access to sensitive work sites must each hold a valid reliability status granted or approved by CISD/PWGSC. Unscreened personnel may access public/reception zones which include Esquimalt Harbour.

Q9.) Can the contractor assume moorage for a water taxi will be made available and that unscreened personnel can be escorted to and from this mooring location for the duration of this work? If yes, can PWGSC please provide possible locations for this moorage?

A9.) Moorage for a water taxi will not be provided as part of this contract.

Q10.) Will any parking be made available for the contractors personnel?

A10.) Parking will not be made available on DND property.

Q11.) What is the required grain size of the siderite?

A11.) As per Specification 35 37 10 (Material Placement) - Clause 2.1.2, Material Type 2 (siderite) is required to be in granular form (composed of approximately sand-size particles). The granular siderite will meet the following specified gradation range: Sieve Size No.4 (95 to 100% passing by weight) to Sieve Size No.30 (0-5% passing by weight). The Contractor must submit product specification sheets for the selected siderite to the Departmental Representative for review and acceptance prior to ordering the material.
