#### **Description of the Requirement:**

The Department of Natural Resources has a requirement to define a real property governance and business model, processes, performance standards and reporting, financial framework, project management framework and real property strategies that will enable NRCan real property to assume its role as a prudent owner investor, manage real property risks and achieve its vision.

#### **Level of Security Requirement:**

The following security requirement (SRCL and related clauses provided by the Contract Security Program apply and form part of the Contract:

Security requirement for Canadian supplier: Public Works and Government Services Canada file #Common-Professional Services Security Requirement Check List #23

- The Contractor/Offeror must, at all times during the performance of the Contract/Standing Offer/Supply Arrangement, hold a valid Facility Security Clearance at the level of **Secret**, with approved Document safeguarding at the level of **Secret**, issued by the Canadian Industrial Security Directorate (CISD), Public Works and Government Services Canada (PWGSC)
- The Contractor/Offeror personnel requiring access to protected/classified information, assets or sensitive work site(s) must EACH hold a valid personnel security screening at the level of Reliability Status, Confidential or Secret as required, granted or approved by the CISD/PWGSC
- The Contractor must not utilize its Information Technology systems to electronically process, produce or store any sensitive protected/classified information until CISD/PWGSC has issued written approval. After approval has been granted, these tasks may be performed up to the level of Secret

- 4. Subcontracts which contain security requirements are not to be awarded without the prior written permission of CISD/PWGSC
- 5. The Contractor/Offeror must comply with the provisions of the:
  - 1. Security Requirements Check List and security guide (if applicable), attached at Annex
  - 2. Industrial Security Manual (Latest Edition)

# **Proposed period of contract:**

The proposed period of contract shall be from <u>date of contract award</u> to <u>March 31, 2020.</u>

The Contractor grants to Canada the irrevocable option to extend the term of the Contract by up to <a href="two-additional-six-month-periods">two-additional-six-month-periods</a> under the same conditions. The Contractor agrees that, during the extended period of the Contract, it will be paid in accordance with the applicable provisions as set out in the Basis of Payment.

Canada may exercise this option at any time by sending a written notice to the Contractor at least three calendar days before the expiry date of the Contract. The option may only be exercised by the Contracting
