This Amendment is being raised to extend the bid closing date until November 29, 2019 and incorporate the following information into Solicitation W2604-19DZ12/A:

### **Q&A**

Question 1: Is there any opportunity to provide a bid for just 1 year? The reason for my question is that it is very difficult to provide a fair price today, for the next three years. Lubricants are subject to a few market drivers, the biggest would be crude oil pricing, currency and lastly additive costs, and the latter is influenced by the first two.

Answer 1: No, the Offeror must offer pricing for all items listed at Annex B – Basis of Payment. The Offeror is able to update the prices of the items listed at Annex B – Basis of Payment, prior to the start of Standing Offer Year 2 and Year 3.

The Offeror must provide price support (e.g. published price list or notification letter with details of any pricing activity) to support the adjusted pricings. Please see below for changes to the solicitation document.

### **1. Page 13 of 19, the following clauses will be added to the solicitation document:**

#### **6.12 Price Adjustment - Petroleum Products**

1. The prices detailed in the Standing Offer are subject to upward or downward adjustment to allow for:
  - a. changes due to price adjustment in petroleum products that are a direct result of increased or decreased prices imposed by the petroleum producer. A copy of the Offeror's notification of price increase or decrease from the petroleum producer must be provided to the Standing Offer Authority; and/or
  - b. imposition of any new or changes to any existing levies, tariffs or fees of whatsoever nature applicable to any petroleum product, authorized, imposed or agreed to by Canada or any provincial government or by any Governmental Regulatory Authority.
2. The Standing Offer will be revised to reflect the actual price of the increase or decrease at time of delivery. The Offeror must not invoice at prices other than those specified in the Standing Offer.

### **2. Page 14 of 19, Annex A – Requirement:**

#### **5. Price Adjustment**

The Offeror is able to update the prices of the items listed at Annex B – Basis of Payment, thirty (30) days prior to the start of Standing Offer Year 2 and Year 3. The Offeror must provide price support (e.g. published price list or notification letter with details of any pricing activity) for the adjusted pricings, subject to review and approval by the Standing Offer Authority.

### **3. Page 15 of 19, Annex B – Basis of Payment:**

Add:

If applicable, the Offeror must submit the adjusted pricings for Standing Offer Year 2 and Standing Offer Year 3, thirty (30) days prior to the start of each year.

*All other terms and conditions remain the same*
