Response(s) (R) to Question(s) (Q):

#### Q1.

Regarding Part 3, Section II, Item 1.1: Is the price breakdown referred to in this section required? The language used indicates that it is "requested", rather than required or mandatory. It is my understanding that the Financial Bid is to be evaluated exclusively based on the amounts provided in "Annex B – Basis of Payment". If the Financial Bid submitted consisted only of the completed "Annex B – Basis of Payment" and the items indicated in Part 3, Section II, Item 1.2, and did not include a price breakdown, would the bid be considered non-responsive?

### <u>R1</u>

The Price Breakdown found on page 7 in Part 3, Section II, 1.1 is only required "as applicable". As per Part 3, Section 2, 1. Financial Bid, Bidders must submit the financial bid in accordance with the Basis of Payment in Annex B.

If the Financial Bid submitted consisted only of the completed "Annex B – Basis of Payment", the bid would be considered responsive.

### <u>Q2</u>

If the answer to the above is "yes, the price breakdown is strictly mandatory", will the content of that breakdown be evaluated, assessed, or considered in any way? If so, how?

### R2

As stated above in the response to Question 1, only the Basis of Payment in Annex B is required for a financial bid.

### Q3

"Annex A – Statement of Work" provides a sample schedule that might work for this training. In previous deliveries of this training for WSC, "travel days" have been considered "work days". So one travel day followed by 6 training days would total 7 consecutive work days which was previously not permitted. Based on the information provided in this section it appears this is now not only permitted but necessary in order to comply with the 14 day maximum. Please confirm that travel days are not to be considered work days for the purposes of determining training schedule, and that a travel day immediately preceding or following six consecutive training days is permissible.

#### R3

Environment and Climate Change Canada has reviewed the example provided in the Request for Proposal, and due to the length of training, we have made the decision that we will allow the currently specified consecutive workdays and travel days, thus leaving the total length of the training to be 14 days. No changes are required.

#### **Q4**

Annex C, Point Rated Technical Criterion 1 (R1) requires the bidder to identify two proposed primary locations for the training. Annex B – Basis of Payment requires travel costs to be indicated if they are necessary. Where travel costs are different for the two proposed locations, should only the location with the lower travel costs be used in calculating the travel costs to appear in Annex B?

#### R4

Please refer to the amendment to Annex B, Basis of Payment below.

#### Q5

Mandatory Technical Criterion 1 requires the submission of course outlines for each of the nine courses included in this training program, with each outline requiring 10 different elements. As these are mandatory, am I correct in determining that if one of these 90 elements (nine courses x 10 elements) is deemed less than satisfactory, the mandatory criterion is not met and the bid is therefore declare non-responsive?

### R5

Mandatory Technical Criterion 1 is met through the provision of the information requested. A bidder must provide an outline for each of the 9 training courses that includes the 10 elements listed.

## <u>Q6</u>

Regarding Appendix C – Attachment 1 – R2 – Point Scale, the right most column is headed "Maximum Number of Points per course (based on instructor/participant ratio)". Using the Wilderness Survival course as an example, it is clear that the 15 points available are based on 3 points being awarded per instructor, and 5 instructors being required to satisfy the 1:5 ratio of instructor to participants for a group of 25 participants (3 points x 5 instructors = 15). This however is not a realistic scenario for this bidder and is not how we have run this training in the past nor would we propose to do so in the future. If 25 individuals were attending the training, we would divide them into two smaller groups, and run two deliveries of this (and many other) training component(s). This would result in one group of 12 participants, and one group of 13 participants completing this course, with each group accompanied by 3 instructors. Furthermore, the three instructors would be the same for both groups, rendering the 3 points x 5 instructors method of evaluating instructor experience inapplicable. Similarly, we would not use 7 different instructors to deliver the Aircraft Underwater Egress training. We would use the same team of fewer instructors to deliver the training to multiple groups of participants. How should this reality be addressed in this section?
