Question #1	With respect to criteria RT3 (page 19), what is meant by "industrial activities"?
Answer #1	Industrial activity refers to any activity that is directly related to manufacturing, processing or raw materials storage areas at an industrial plant
Question #2	Has the Department of National Defence (DND) refreshed its hazardous substances program at the similar scale before? If yes, what was the last time?
Answer #2	DND has not made significantly large revisions to its hazardous substances program since approximately 2000.
Question #3	Can we propose a small team to do the work? If yes, is it still valid that the combination experience of the team meets all Mandatory Technical Criteria and Point Rated Technical Criteria?
Answer #3	For bidding purposes, the proposed lead resource will be assessed and must meet the mandatory criteria and minimum points for the point-rated criteria. DND will not assess supporting team members. For executing the work, this lead resource must be present and can work with a supporting team.
Question #4	Can we propose multiple candidates for DND to pick and choose the best one out of them?
Answer #4	The bidder must identify a lead resource and only that resource will be assessed and must meet the mandatory criteria and minimum points for the point-rated criteria.
Question #5	Can DND give a few examples on where the hazard materials/substances that this program deals with are mainly from? i.e., from buildings/facilities, labs, lands, equipment, manufacturing lines, waste, oil gasoline pipelines, roads, transportation of hazardous goods, or others?
Answer #5	Please review the Statement of Work, Annex "A". The consultant will provide a Hazardous Substances Program. The substances may originate from any number of sources.
Question #6	Would you consider extending the submission deadline to Dec 9?
Answer #6	We would like to keep the deadline at December 2nd.
