**2. Questions and Answers:**

Question 1:

The course that I teach is one that I developed, from scratch. It was developed with adult education principles as well as H & S Legislation requirements for training on equipment.

It is NOT one of the certifying bodies listed.

Is there any chance that I could send course materials, samples, references, etc. as a substitute?

Answer 1:

The bidder's course materials and training program must fit within the guidelines as stated in M1 of Annex E – Evaluation Criteria.

Note that the below criteria may not include all of the certifying bodies provided by Industry, but proof demonstrating that the bidder is recognized by industry as an official trainer of Chainsaw Safety must be provided.

*M1 - Industry certified means that the training provided by the Bidder will result in certification recognized by the industry to include, **but not limited to:** International Society of Arboriculture (ISA), Canadian Standards Association (CSA), Woodland Trainers Association (WTA), Arboriculture Canada.*

***Proof of documentation from the industry must be in the form of a letter / certificate demonstrating the bidder is recognized as an official trainer to deliver training to educational, governmental industry association or multiple industry sites.***

***Certification that is only recognized by a specific company or work site location, does not meet this standard and will be not be accepted.***

Question 2:

In ANNEX A, Subsection 3.0.e. and 4.0.d.

Will there be any forested area, where trees can be fallen for the 'tree felling' practical portion, available at any of the institutions. If so, what institutions have access to forested areas?

Response 2:

Most sites do not have access to forested areas within the Institutional boundaries. However, if offenders are approved by Correctional Service Canada for Escorted Temporary Absences (ETA), participants may be able to access forested areas to fell a tree. In some locations, the forested area is only a few feet outside the property boundary. The designated manager will confirm access to a forested area for training at time of booking.



In situations where there are not trees available to fell, we would ask the bidder/bidder's resources to provide extra practical time in cutting. This may include setting up a stand and placing a log vertically to mimic the felling of a tree. The Annex A – Statement of Work, section 3.0 – Tasks, d) specifies the requirement for a training program that must allow for flexible completion of certificates as per graduated levels: awareness, basic, and intermediate.

The designated manager can confirm at the time of booking whether there will be access to a forested area.

**Note:** Chainsaw Safety Training for the Edmonton Institution for Women will be conducted at Elk Island National Park and will have access to a forested area.

**Question 3:**

The question is regarding Section III – Certifications, Subsection 1.4 – Status and Availability of Resources.

We are trying to determine our capacity of possibly hosting this training. Therefore, I would need to know if the maximum amount a program can be hosted is per institution or per security level?

For Example: Stream 1: Bowden Institution: this institution has both: minimum and medium security. Bowden also has a listed maximum of three (3) deliveries per year. Does this mean, within the year, the Bowden Institution can book a program for minimum security up to three (3) times **AND** a program for medium security up to three (3) times; for a total of six (6) potential deliveries at the Bowden institution?

**Answer 1:**

No, it does not mean a total of six (6) potential deliveries at the Bowden Institution.

The estimated number of courses listed for this site, is the combined total number of potential sessions to be delivered per year at the institution, regardless of security level.

For example: Bowden Institution's "Estimated Number of Sessions per year" is listed as "Up to 3 Courses". This means there would be no more than 3 courses booked at the Institution. The 3 sessions may be split between security levels (i.e. 2 sessions delivered to minimum level and 1 session to medium level), or all 3 available sessions delivered just to one security level. (i.e. 3 sessions delivered to minimum level and 0 sessions to medium level)
